



To All Weymouth Youth Hockey Parents and Players:

### **Registration 2009/2010 Season**

- **Online Registration** begins March 1, 2009 for all levels
- **Walk-in Registration** will be held on Monday, March 2, 2009 from 7-9PM at the Weymouth Elks (downstairs)
- **Deadline for Registration** is May 1, 2009 for all levels other than Instructional. The deadline for registrations at the Instructional level is October 1, 2009.
- **Waiting List** – All registrations received after the deadline will be placed on a waiting list.
- **Outstanding Balances** - All previous balances **must be paid** prior to acceptance of registration for the 2009/2010 season.

### **WYH General Meeting**

The WYH General Meeting will be held in April at the Weymouth Elks. This meeting is open to all parents, providing a forum for the membership to take part in the betterment of our program. Please plan to attend. A date for the general meeting will be posted on the WYH website.

### **Tuition Policy**

Tuition for the 2009/2010 full season and Midget level teams **must be paid in full prior to September 1st, 2009 or your child will not be allowed to participate.** Please contact the treasurer at [treasurer@weymouthyouthhockey.net](mailto:treasurer@weymouthyouthhockey.net) to make arrangements if you will be unable to pay by this deadline.

### **Upfront Fees for the 2009/2010 Season**

#### **Tuition**

- **Skaters**
  - The 2009/2010 tuition for full season players at all levels is \$900.00
    - \$800 tuition
    - \$100 fundraising fee (see Fundraising Fee section below for details)
  - Short season teams (Midgets, Girls U16 and Girls U19) is \$450.00.
  - Instructional tuition is \$500.00.
- **Goalies with their own equipment**
  - The 2009/2010 tuition for full season goalies at all levels is \$350.
    - \$250 tuition
    - \$100 fundraising fee (see Fundraising Fee section below for details)
  - The tuition for goalies for short season teams will be \$125.

### **Fundraising Fee**

Weymouth Youth Hockey recognizes that we are all affected by our current economic situation. In order to continue to offer a quality and affordable program, while simultaneously giving our families an opportunity to reduce their individual overhead, we are introducing a mandatory fundraising event. Each full season player is required to pre-pay \$100.00 (one hundred) for this event. The player will receive \$100.00 (one hundred) worth of raffle tickets which they will sell for \$10.00 (ten) each as a means of "reimbursement" for the upfront fundraising fee paid at registration. Families are not restricted to the number of raffle tickets they can sell. All funds collected from the first book are retained by the player's family, subsequent books can be purchased for \$50, providing an opportunity to significantly reduce or eliminate your tuition cost for the season.

Prizes and other details are still being considered. We will post those details on the website as soon as possible.

## **USA Hockey / Mass Hockey Online Registration**

**Tuition DOES NOT include the \$35.00 Registration Fee for USA and Mass Hockey.** All players will be required beginning May 1, 2009 to register online with USA/Mass Hockey and send the confirmation code to the registrar. USA/Mass hockey registrations must be received by the registrar before your first on ice session. The link to register online will be emailed on May 1 and be on the Weymouth Youth Hockey website.

The initial payment is \$300.00 of which there is a non refundable/transferable deposit is \$250.00. The payment of \$300.00 must accompany the completed Registration Form, Parent Awareness Form, and Participant Code of Conduct Form, all of which have been provided. Registrations without an initial payment made by June 1, 2009 will be removed from any team selections and placed on a waiting list. The fee for tryouts for an A or B team at any level is \$50.00 due at the time of registration. All payments to Weymouth Youth Hockey are non-refundable and non-transferable. A \$50.00 charge will be applied for any checks returned unpaid for any reason. One check payable to Weymouth Youth Hockey may be used for registration. This packet contains all the information necessary for registrations and tryouts. **Please read all information.** The following is an additional list that may answer some of your questions.

- Tryouts for all level A & B teams are optional. All Players opting to tryout **must attend all** tryout sessions. Absences could jeopardize your placement on any team.
- **All first year Pee Wee level players must attend the checking clinic. No exceptions!**
- All forms in this packet must be filled out completely for acceptance of registration. Additional registration forms may be downloaded from the Weymouth Youth Hockey Website at [www.weymouthyouthhockey.net](http://www.weymouthyouthhockey.net).
- **Arrive early** for all tryout sessions to allow for time for checking in and tryout number assignments. **Check-in required for all sessions. Players are not to wear team shirts or shirts with their name showing.**
- Following the Skills Sessions the player will be assigned a scrimmage team that will be posted to the web site with the dates, times, and locations of the scrimmage games.
- At this time, **Individuals interested in Head coaching must complete a Coaching Application and CORI form by Tuesday, April 1, 2009.** Coaching applications are part of the registration packet or may be downloaded from the Weymouth Youth Hockey website [www.weymouthyouthhockey.net](http://www.weymouthyouthhockey.net). All coaches must put CEP Number on Coaches Application and **must** be patched at the appropriate level by December 31, 2009.

## REGISTRATION/TRYOUT PROCEDURES 2009/2010

### Registration

Sunday, March 1, 2009- Online Registration begins for all levels

Monday, March 2, 2009 - Walk-in registration at the Weymouth Elks (downstairs)

Friday, May 1, 2009 – Deadline for WYH registration

### Tryouts

Optional tryouts for A & B teams will be held in accordance with the procedures listed below. A schedule of dates and times will be posted on the Weymouth Youth Hockey website and at the Connell Rink. Players electing to tryout **must** attend all scheduled sessions. Players registering at this time that elect not to tryout will be placed on a Yankee Conference “C” level team.

### Selection of Coaches

Coaches will be selected after tryouts are completed and scores are calculated. This will allow coaches to be placed at the same level team that their child qualifies for. Individuals interested in coaching must complete the Coaching Application and CORI form, **even if you have coached for WYH during the prior year(s)**, and return to the registrar - Pat McCarthy – at [registrar@weymouthyouthhockey.net](mailto:registrar@weymouthyouthhockey.net) or mail to PO Box890253 02189 a. If you are interested in coaching a south Shore Conference team, **Coaches Applications and CORI forms are due by April 1, 2009.**

### Tryout Procedures/Scoring/Player Selection

In order to ensure an objective and non-biased tryout, the following procedures will be used for the 2009/2010 season:

- WYH Coaches and Level Directors will be scoring players throughout the tryouts.
- Tryout sessions will consist of 1 skills session and 2 hours of scrimmage games for all levels
- For girls who want to skate for the Girls U12, Girls U14, U16 and GU19 short Season **only**, there is no tryout required.
- For girls who want to tryout for a coed South Shore Conference team, there is a tryout fee.
- For girls who want to play Girls U12 or Girls U14 and either a Yankee Conference or South Shore Conference team, you will be billed accordingly.

### Selections of Mite and Squirt teams will be as follows:

- A-teams; top 5 ranked players are automatic. For the remainder of the team, the coach will then select the balance of players from the remaining list. This does include the goalie (13 skaters plus a goalie is a minimum roster).
- B-teams; of the remaining players on the list, The top 5 ranked are automatic; for the remainder of the team, the coach will then select balance of the players from the remaining players on the list. This does include the goalie (13 skaters plus a goalie is a minimum roster).
- In the case of two B-teams, the selections will be as follows: top 10 ranked players are automatic and will be divided among the two teams as evenly as possible based on total scores. For the remainder of the teams, the coaches will then select the balance of the players from the list. This does include the goalies. (13 skaters plus a goalie is a

minimum roster). Goalies will be selected by the head coach of that team.

**Selection of Pee wee and Bantam teams will be as follows:**

- All Players must declare a position- (forward or defense)
- A-Team: Top 3 ranked Forwards, and top 2 ranked defenseman are automatic. For the remainder of the team, the coach will then select balance of the players from the remaining players on the list. This does include the goalie (13 skaters plus a goalie is a minimum roster). .
- B-team; of remaining players on list, Top 3 ranked Forwards, and top 2 ranked defenseman are automatic. For the remainder of the team, the coach will then select balance of the players from the remaining players on the list. This does include the goalie (13 skaters plus a goalie is a minimum roster).
- In the case of two B-teams, the selections will be as follows top 6 ranked forward players are automatic and the top 4 ranked defensemen are automatic and will be divided among the two teams as evenly as possible based on total scores. Coaches will then select balance of the players from the remaining players on the list. This does include the goalies (13 skaters plus a goalie is a minimum roster). Goalies will be selected by the head coach of that team.

**All Goalies – at all levels MUST attend all skills sessions, goalie skills and scrimmage games for their age appropriate level.**

**All players will be placed at their age appropriate level regardless of skill or parental wishes. All of the South Shore Conference A and B team's rosters are subject to Board approval.**

All previous balances must be paid prior to acceptance of registration for the 2009/2010 season. A non-refundable, non-transferable payment of \$300.00 must accompany the completed Registration Form, Parent Awareness Form, and the Participant Code of Conduct Form all of which are attached. If a player is attending the tryouts, a tryout fee of \$50.00 should also be included. One check payable to Weymouth Youth Hockey may be used for registration.
