### *Message from the Board of Directors*

Please join us for our board meetings on the third Wednesday of every month at 6:30 p.m. Our next meeting is coming up on April 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. Everyone is welcome to come out and see how you can help our association grow the game. **We are in need of volunteers, and we could use YOUR help!**

**Please note there is a change in the fee needed at tryouts this year.** Families with one player trying out will need to bring a total of \$160 (non-refundable with \$100 toward tryouts and \$60 toward 400 Club fundraising tickets). Families with multiple players will be responsible for only one extra fundraising ticket (for a total of \$90 in fundraising). We do anticipate a subsequent \$100 fundraiser, like Hockeymania tickets, later in the season.

Anyone who would prefer not to participate in the two mandatory fundraisers for the association may opt out at the time of tryouts for an additional fee.

Only 400 tickets will be sold, and all tickets will be drawn. The first and every tenth ticket drawn will win \$20 each.
