Shirley Grider and Jeff Roach were nominated for those two vacated LAHA board positions. Dash moved and Scott seconded that they be voted by acclamation onto the LAHA board and it was unanimous. The LAHA board officer positions will be voted on at the next LAHA Board meeting.

Jim Sprinkle is retiring as registrar and Suzanne Coyne has offered to be the LAHA registrar for next year. John Archuleta is also leaving LAHA as the equipment manager and he is being replaced by Chris Thorne. Thank you to Jim and John for their years of service

Jeff Walterscheid volunteered to serve on the LAHA committee as the HDHL scheduling representative.

**LAHA/County Relations- Dianne Marquez**

LA County will be at LAHA registration next year to offer the ice rink passes and avoid the confusion we had this year in doing the passes separately. The county would like a parent volunteer to help cover working at the rink during LAHA practice times because they need a second person to cover their county employees during all practice times, games and tournaments. This would be an excellent way to reduce the county costs and the associated recharges to LAHA. The county may be able to offer scholarship credits in return for working as a second person at the rink.

### **Financial Report – Scott Havemann**

LAHA is sound but we are slightly below the same levels as last year because we bought a lot of extra equipment this year. Revenues increased from \$24K to \$38K this year but we spent more than we brought in this year. We spent \$2K on a storage shed, \$2.5K on boards, \$10K on 60 new sets of ATOM's sized rental gear and had costs for other assorted equipment. We started the year with \$18K and these equipment expenses are not expected to repeat next year. We are seeking fundraiser opportunities, comments and input for next year activities.

### **Referee Report – Craig Wehner**

We need more adult referees and are going to try to provide some more training opportunities locally.

### **Head Coach's Report- Dash Weeks**

The season went well and we increased from 130 kids last year to over 200 this year. The ATOMS (begin to skate) program was very well received and we will repeat it next year. There were 58 ATOMS participants this year.

Please turn in coaches and LAHA evaluation forms. We need the comments to improve the programs.

Equipment return will be April 13th from 5:30-8:30 PM at the rink.

There are a lot of summer activities and these are posted on the LAHA website. There is summer roller hockey and deck hockey being offered as well.
