

Youth Boys Officiating Classes: February 25 and March 4

For anyone interested in becoming a boys youth lacrosse official, there will annual classroom trainings on Sunday, February 25 (at Rocky Rococo Pizza-West, 7952 Tree Lane, Madison, WI) from 12:00-4:00 and Sunday, March 4 (at Evco Plastics, 100 W. North St. Deforest, WI 53532) from 1:00-5:00. Please note that you must attend **both** 4 hour classroom sessions as well as an "on-field" training session (Time and location yet to be determined) to become a certified boys youth lacrosse official. Food will be provided to officials at the classroom sessions. Anyone is welcome to come and audit the training sessions. All officials will be required to pay a training fee before the end of the last classroom training session (that fee will not be determined until next month, however, it is expected to be around \$45). *There is a second set of training dates anticipated for the Milwaukee area (dates TBD), but individuals who cannot attend the second session can pick up that session at a later time in Milwaukee.*

The requirements for officiating boys youth lacrosse games are as follows:

- 1) Attend both classroom sessions
- 2) Attend an on-field training session
- 3) Be at least a sophomore in high school
- 4) Be an active US Lacrosse member
- 5) Pass the on-line US Lacrosse official's certification exams
