1. Register - Three Times!

2. Register with Montana Lacrosse Officials Association, Send a request to join training to:

Training is free of charge

3. Register as an "Official" with US Lacrosse. Pay for your level of membership.

NOTE: Please keep all receipts. NWLA will reimburse all expenses.

(If you are already a US Lacrosse member, call USL membership department to ensure they list you as both an Official and a Player or Coach. Then request a rule book mailed to you ASAP.
