



Southbury Youth Baseball 2017 Memorial Tournament Information



- Home team (listed first on the game schedule) will have the batting cage for 30 minutes starting one hour before game start time. Visitors will have the cage for 30 minutes starting 30 minutes before game start time. Each team should get 10-15 minutes of field time while the other is using the cages. Home team has the first base dugout. No BP on the fields please.
- Tournament will be governed by Cal Ripken 2017 tournament rules.
- If a pitcher hits two batters in one inning or during the game, he will be warned by the umpire that the next batter he hits (#3), he will be removed as pitcher. He cannot be substituted later in the game as a pitcher or reenter the game as a pitcher. He can stay in the game and play any other position.
- Teams must use a rolling batting order (e.g. every child is in the batting order regardless of whether they are playing in the field during any particular inning.)
- The two teams with the best records following the completion of pool play will qualify for the championship game. In case of a tie, the following Babe Ruth tiebreaker criteria apply:
 - 1) Head to Head competition
 - 2) Fewest runs allowed during pool play
 - 3) Coin toss
- Each team should identify a protest committee person prior to the game.
- We will be conducting 50-50 raffle contests during each game, with the proceeds going to the Jimmy Fund.
- On Saturday we will have an expanded menu at our snack shed so players/fans don't have to worry about bringing lunches. Burgers, hot dogs, chips, etc. will be on the menu, along with our full stock of beverages.
- If Saturday gets rained out, the entire schedule will move to Sunday, and Sunday to Monday. We will try to complete the tournament on Monday which might require back to back doubleheaders for the teams in the championship game. Let's hope for good weather!

- From Waterbury take I-84W to Exit 15, right off exit, left onto Main St. South, right onto Poverty Rd. to Ewald Park.
- From New Milford take 67S to right on 172S to left on Main St. South to left on Old Field Rd. to left on Poverty Rd. to Ewald Park.
