

This is written for coaches and manager to understand the 2010 MYSA end of season playoff structure, fees, and commitments. Unfortunately the MYSA playoff structure is necessarily complex because of the huge variance in the size of the age groups. Some age groups have as few as 7 teams statewide while others have over 100. Obviously designing a single playoff system was a challenge for MYSA.

For 2010, there are 3 main components to post season play.

League Playoffs

- July 15th to 18th, 2010

 - CC United DOES NOT pay these costs; individual teams are responsible

Regional Playoffs

- July 20–22, 2010 (rain day: July 23, 2010)

- CC United will reimburse teams for the registration fees associated with Region

State

- July 24–30, 2010
- Details, locations, and fees can be found [here](#)
- CC United will reimburse teams for the registration fees associated with State
