



FC Europa Parent Code of Conduct

- Cheer for your children, but do not try to coach them from the sidelines. Do not make any negative remarks to players on your team or the opposing team.
- Respect the game officials and refrain from addressing them or questioning their decisions. Anyone making any negative comments towards a referee will be asked to leave the field area, and repeat offenders will be barred from attending future games.
- Realize, accept and practice the principles that a team's reputation is built not only on its playing ability, but also on the sportsmanship, courtesy, and citizenship of its fans. Demonstrate appropriate gestures of sportsmanship at the conclusion of a game, win or lose.
- The club encourages open dialogue between parents and coaches, but such discussions should occur at times that do not interfere with team activities. If you have an area of disagreement with your Coach, allow a 24-hour "cooling off" period before contacting him/her to discuss the matter. Recognize that your Coach is responsible for all game decision making, including player positioning, playing time, formation, and tactical decisions.
- Decrease the pressure to win. Remember that soccer is a game and is meant to be fun.
