



## FC Europa Player Code of Conduct

- Treat other players, coaches, supporters and officials with respect, and encourage other players to do the same. Verbal abuse and harassment in any form will not be tolerated. Recognize that you are representing our club each time you put on your uniform.
- Agree to attend and be fully prepared for all practices, games and functions as required. Provide advance notice to your Coach and Team Manager if you are unable to attend a practice or game.
- Take care of your body by eating a healthy diet, avoiding dangerous or harmful activities and substances, and getting plenty of sleep. Report any medical problems immediately to your parents and Coach. Familiarize yourself with the club's Concussion Prevention resources.
- Recognize that your Coach is in charge of all game-time decisions, including playing time, positioning, formations, and tactical decisions. If there are issues you would like to discuss with your Coach, arrange for a private meeting that does not interfere with team activities (the parents of younger players should be involved in these discussions).
