**Alan Carr Memorial Scholarship
Established 1998**

About Alan Carr: Alan Carr was a youth soccer coach and officer of Haddonfield Soccer Club who died in 1997 at the age of 46. He was extraordinarily dedicated to the hundreds of boys and girls who have participated in HSC's recreational and competitive travel programs. Alan wanted to see every player participate to the best of their abilities and always gave special attention to those who needed it, so that they could feel a part of the team and truly enjoy the game of soccer. He was an exemplary leader, role model, and teacher of the game who was loved by colleagues and children in the program. This scholarship award celebrates Alan's contributions to the lives of our children.

Scholarship Committee: The Alan Carr scholarship committee shall consist of at least six members. One non-voting chairperson who will serve as the custodian of the process. He/She receives the applications, logs them in for tracking purposes and removes any references to the name of the candidate so that the applications are reviewed by the committee without knowing the names of the applicants. He/she would also record votes and report back to the HSC board. The other five voting members shall consist of at least two current board members with the remaining members consisting of coaches, parents, and/or club members. Terms of the committee members shall be for two-years. Relatives of a candidate can not participate in the selection process.

Eligibility: Any current senior student at Haddonfield Memorial High School who has played youth soccer in the HSC program and will attend college in the fall. The scholarship winners must stay in school for at least one full academic year or they will forfeit their right to the scholarship and it will be expected that the individual will return the funds to the soccer club if this requirement is not met.

Scholarship Criteria: The scholarships will be awarded to current or former soccer players who are also outstanding citizens. Awards will be primarily based upon the following criteria: (1) citizenship/leadership and activities that demonstrate a true role model in the community, (2) soccer and a demonstrated love and passion for the game of soccer throughout the candidate's participation career. Also included in the criteria will be an individual's academic/scholastic and associated honors as well as any outside (non-school related) honors.

Number and Amount of Awards: Each year, two awards will be made – one to a senior male student and one to a senior female student. The awards will be in the amount of \$1000. each. In future years, awards guidelines and criteria may change at the discretion of the Board of Directors of HSC.

Application: Candidates should fill out the attached application form and submit it to HSC **no later than Friday May 17th**. **Applicants are welcome to use extra sheets if more space is needed. Along with their application, all applicants shall submit the following: (1) two letters of recommendation, with one from a non-soccer source that can address citizenship, leadership and dedication. (2) A statement, no longer than one page in length, which the applicant describes how soccer and his/her soccer experiences in Haddonfield Soccer have influenced him/her. All information must be truthful and accurate.**
