The organization does not maintain or carry health insurance for the minor. The organization does not assume any financial liability, responsibility, or obligation for or to provide assistance with expense, damage, injury, medical payments, health payments, or disability payments.

Covid Terms and Conditions

Pine Richland Mini Cheerleading Camp offers the following guidelines to assist parents/guardians, campers, & camp staff (cheerleaders) to comply with the directives and guidance from the PA Dept. of Health and the CDC and the Pine Richland School District. An addendum to these Terms and Condition will be provided separately when the school district guidelines are made public in July. The safety and well-being of our campers & cheerleaders is of utmost importance and our number one priority. This is a total team effort and will demand diligence and responsibility on all sides.

Pine Richland Mini Cheerleading Camp will be a non-contact cheer camp. A “No-Touch” rule will be in effect for the duration of camp.

Pine Richland Mini Cheerleading Camp has a strict maximum camp enrollment number.

- To comply with CDC recommendations, campers will be placed in groups of 5-10 campers.
- A cheerleader to camper ratio of 1:10.
- On a designated area, no more than 25 people, which includes camp staff.
- There will be a specific designated drop off & pick up location within Richland Park.

The following guidelines will be in place and enforced during camp –

Arrival to Camp Location:

1. All parents/guardians, campers, & cheerleaders must adhere to six-foot physical distancing while at camp location and on premises.
2. Parents/guardians must conduct daily symptom assessment on their child(ren) pre check-in. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
3. Campers are strongly recommended to travel to camp locations alone or with siblings, and with a member of immediate family. (No carpooling).
4. Digital non-touch temperature checks will be administered to every camper and cheerleader upon arrival.
5. During daily check-in (drop off), all parents/guardians, campers, and cheerleaders must wear face coverings.

Active Participation During Camp:

1. Campers and cheerleaders must adhere to six-foot distancing recommendations.
2. During active play, face coverings will NOT be required.
3. Multiple hand sanitizer will be set up at throughout the area.
4. Volunteer parents will be required to wear gloves.
5. Campers are required to bring their own water jug or refillable water bottle that CANNOT be shared.
6. Campers must remain in their own designated area.
7. Absolutely no sharing or trading of water or snacks.
8. Six-foot social distancing guidelines will be in effect.
9. All uneaten food items, drinks, wrappers, packaging, and plastic utensils must be disposed of at conclusion of snack. We want to limit what goes home from camp.

Bathroom:

1. Pre-scheduled bathroom breaks will be given. 1 camper at a time will be allowed in the restroom. Of course “emergency” bathroom breaks will be granted.

Camp Dismissal/Departure:

2. All parents/guardians, campers, & cheerleaders must adhere to six-foot physical distancing while at camp location and on premises.
3. Campers are strongly recommended to travel from camp location alone or with siblings, and with a member of immediate family. (No carpooling).

4. **During daily dismissal (pick up), all parents/guardians, campers, and cheerleaders must wear face coverings.**
5. **Individuals should not congregate in parking lots or open areas following camp drop off or pick up.**
