F-Division Game Policy

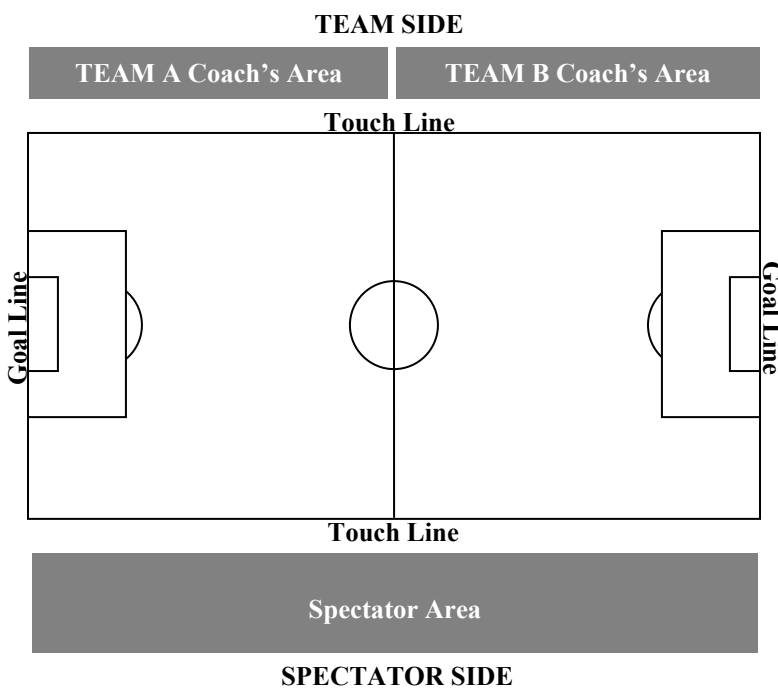

The purpose of this document is to set policies aimed at improving the F-Division soccer game experience for the players. Feel free to contact the Brookfield Soccer Club President (president@brookfieldsoccer.org) if you have any questions.

Over the past few seasons it has been brought to the BSC Board's attention that lopsided games scores and coaching from all sides of the field have negatively impacted the players. To rectify the situation the Board is instituting the following rules effective this season.

New F-Division Rules (effective Fall 2006)

- 1) **The maximum goal differential is 6 goals. When the maximum goal differential is reached, the game is over. (For example, if the score reaches 6-0, 7-1, 8-2, etc. the game is over.) The teams should then be mixed up, particularly the strong players, and should scrimmage for the remainder of the scheduled game time.**
- 2) **No more than 3 coaches per team (head coach plus two assistant coaches) are allowed on the Team Side of the field. Coaches should stay on their half of the field.**
- 3) **Spectators are only allowed on the Spectator Side of the field, located opposite of the Team Side.**
- 4) **No one is allowed anywhere behind the Goal Lines.**
- 5) **Coaching (by spectators or coaches) is not allowed from the Spectator Side.**



Coaches, spectators and players not on the field should be 5 yards away from the Touch Lines
