MITES

12/4/2010 Mites vs. South Windsor A

The Mite A team entered this morning's game against South Windsor with a 9-1 record and our rivals from down south on Route 5 gave us our most competitive game of the year.

The first period ended scoreless with So. Windsor out shooting Enfield 6 shots to 2 but the Eagles had the territorial edge and proved they could skate with South Windsor. The line

of Michael A, Tyler P and Kenny O'K fought extremely hard chasing down loose pucks and pressuring the South Windsor defense. The strong defensive play of Alex F, JC R, Wesley O and Dan B did an excellent good job containing the talented and speedy South Windsor forwards and Ryan G came up with clutch saves when called upon to keep our team in the game.

The defensive pace of the 1st period continued into the 2nd. The line of Remington F, Alex C and Mason F played great two way hockey pressuring the So Windsor defense with crisp passing and slowed down their offense with tough back checking thru the neutral zone, making it difficult for So Windsor to gain offensive momentum. However, with 1 minute left in the 2nd period the offensive drought ended when during a 5 on 3 Enfield power play, Hunter D took a Sam T pass and knocked it home for the first goal of the game.

The Eagles entering the 3rd period with a 1-0 lead but the defensive pace of the game changed and the offense began to open up. At the 9 minute mark of the third period South Windsor tied the game but a minute and half later Hunter D was there again on the rebound knocking home his 2nd goal of the game to give the Eagles a 2-1. However, we were only able to enjoy our lead for 3 minutes because with 4 minutes and 30 seconds left in the game South Windsor tied it up 2-2.

The pace and excitement intensified during the last minutes of the game and with 1:34 left, Enfield called a timeout. The Eagles regrouped for their final push of the game but with 53 seconds left, Enfield was called for a slashing penalty and had to play the final minute plus, one man down. But wait a minute, if the

penalty happened with 53 seconds left in the game how could Enfield play with one man down for over a minute? That's because the South Windsor Arena scorekeeper didn't start the clock after the puck was dropped on the face off. In spite of the extra time South Windsor had at the end of the game they couldn't penetrate the exceptional Eagle defensive unit of Hunter D, Sam T, Wes O and Alex F and the young Eagle mites kept their tie 2-2 and were initiated into the Enfield – South Windsor rivalry.

12/5/2010 Mites vs. Gr Brgport B (@ Shelton)

The mites traveled to Shelton for a 9:45 am match up with the Greater Bridgeport Mite B team (GBJHA). When we arrived at the rink the boys enjoyed the opportunity to watch some of the Bridgeport Sound Tigers practice.

Greater Bridgeport got off to a quick start scoring the first goal of the game when the Eagle defense couldn't clear the puck and GBJHA poked the puck past our goalie, Alex F. Kenny O'K's hard work finally paid off when he fired a shot from the slot beating the Gr Bridgeport goalie, scoring the Eagles first goal of the game and his 1st of the season. Later in the period Remmy F head manned a pass from our defensive zone to a streaking Alex C who broke over the center ice line alone on the goalie and beat him to give the Eagles their first lead of the game and the first period ended 2-1 Enfield.

However, our lead was short lived. During the second period, Greater Bridgeport popped in a pair of goals to retake the lead and the Mites entered the 3rd period trailing 3-2. This was only the second time in 12 games that the Eagles trailed while entering the 3rd period. The lines were reshuffled to increase our offensive threats but the Eagles couldn't beat

the GBpt goalie for most of the period. Half way thru the 3rd period Sam T broke in on a breakaway, deked the goalie to his forehand but shot just wide. To compound our problems with 2 and a half minutes left in the game we were called for a too many men on the ice penalty. The Eagles successfully killed the penalty and with 1:20 seconds left in the game we called a time out, pulled our goalie for an extra skater and sent out Tyler G, Sam T, Remmy F, Hunter, JC R and Dan B and with only 49 seconds in the game a Tyler G shot from the slot beat the GBJHA goalie.

We left Shelton with a tie and hope to get ahead of them in January when they travel to Enfield for a rematch.
