MITES

1/2/11 Enfield Mites (7) vs. W. Hart. B Mites (2)

The Enfield Mite Eagles opened the 2011 portion of the season on Sunday afternoon at Kingswood Oxford School in West Hartford.

The evening before some of the boys enjoyed watching the 2011 Winter Classic and saw the Washington Capital defeat the Pittsburgh Penguins 3-1, outdoors at Heine's Field. The weather conditions in Pittsburgh were rainy and made for soft and wet ice for the pros. The ice conditions in West Hartford were no better. The rink at Kingswood Oxford was warm and the ice conditions were soft and wet in the beginning of the game and choppy for the second half of the game as the water on the ice evaporated and left a soft and bumpy surface. These conditions made our lite blue pucks stick and bounce oddly for most of the game. However both teams had to play on these rather poor ice conditions and the Eagles' steady attack proved to be too much for the West Hartford Wolves.

Tyler G scored the first of his three goal hat trick, 7 minutes into the game on a breakaway. Tyler played exceptional two way hockey centering and anchoring a line with his kid brother Dylan G and Mason F. One minute later Alex F shot a bouncy knuckle ball off the right face of circle for the first of his 2 goals of the game. Remmy F also scored twice. Once mid way thru the 3rd period when he collected on an Alex F rebound and with a minute and a half left in the game when after collecting a pass from Alex C he made some amazing moves stickhandling passed 3 West Hartford defenders and fire a shot past the helpless Wolves goalie.

The pass of the game occurred when Dan B rushed with the puck up ice in his best Bobby Orr impersonation and dished a sweet pass to Tyler G who light the lamp for his hat trick goal.

Sam T made a last minute start in net as the Zamboni was rounding the ice and played well, allowing only 2 goals for the win.

Squirts at Stowe Winter Carnival Tournament

The Enfield Squirt A team traveled to beautiful Stowe, VT for the Winter Carnival Tournament. The tournament was held at the outdoor rink Jackson Arena in the middle of Stowe's town center. The Winter Carnival was in full swing with a lot of activities going on including ice sculpture carving and dog sled rides. For the Eagles, however, this was going to be a weekend full of Hockey.

On the warmest of the three days at 23 degrees, the Eagles faced Hanover Wild from New Hampshire for their first game. On the heels of a fresh snow storm, which canceled school, many of the Eagles had traveled 3.5 hours that day so it would be interesting to see how they responded in the game. Led on the ice by captains Ben K, Ryan M and Nate R the Eagles did take a little while to find their stride. Teams would get a point for each period they won as well as two points for winning the game so it was important to play hard every minute.

Despite the slow start the Eagles got on the board first late in the first period. Robert V received a nice pass from Connor J and sent a shot to the far post for the score.
