Bernie Cassell, Director

Cassell, the Anaheim Ducks skating consultant, brings with him a wealth of hockey coaching and skill instruction experience as Director of Connecticut Pure Hockey.

From 2003-2008 Bernie was a member of the New York Islanders organization as the skating and skills coach and an assistant coach for the Bridgeport Sound Tigers, the top minor league affiliate of the New York Islanders.

As a player, Bernie starred at Cushing Academy and Elmira College, where he earned all-American honors and set the all-time record for goals in a season. Cassell was both an ECAC All-Star and NCAA All-American Selection during his career at Elmira.

He earned a Master's Degree in Education at Connecticut College, along with being the interim women's head coach. He later went on to become head coach at the Junior level (USA Hockey) with the Connecticut based, Norwich Icebreakers.



Camp Directors

Dave Baseggio, Director

Currently a Professional Scout for the NHL's Anaheim Ducks, Baseggio is one of Connecticut Pure Hockey's directors. With over 10 years experience in professional hockey management, Baseggio joined the Ducks after serving as head coach of the AHL's Peoria Rivermen, the St. Louis Blues top affiliate.

Prior to joining the Rivermen, the Niagara Falls, Ontario, native spent five seasons with the New York Islanders AHL's Bridgeport Sound Tigers coaching staff, as an assistant and head coach. During his time with the Sound Tigers, Baseggio saw the club advance to the Calder Cup Finals, coached at the AHL All-Star game and was named a finalist for the AHL's Coach of the Year.

A graduate of Yale University in 1989 with a B.A. in Economics, Baseggio captained the Bulldogs hockey team. He earned ECAC All-Star honors in his final three seasons and holds the Bulldogs' all-time scoring record for a defenseman.

Following college, Baseggio was drafted by the Buffalo Sabres as a fourth-round pick (68th overall) in the 1986 NHL Draft and played professionally for 11 seasons in the AHL and IHL, and was a two-time IHL All-Star.
