Reports

President:

- Jarry announced that an audit by USA hockey will be conducted in the very near future. Anyone who wants to be on the audit committee feel free to let Jarry know.

Referee in Chief:

- How to become a referee has been very successful. Over 250 individuals have signed up. One more session coming up.
- August 1st Officials registration opens.
- Upcoming referee clinics and information is posted on the CHC website.

- This was a rule change year and there were 2 or 3 important ones.
 - 9 Dots- face offs will only take place at 1 of the 9 dots.
 - Icing- short-handed and you ice the puck, it's now icing. Will get a whistle.
 - If the puck hits the goal post and goes out of play the face off will go inside.

- Mandatory midget coaches meeting will be held on July 25 at Shelton Rink. Each declared team must submit a check from the host organization for \$1,200 per team. If a team does not meet the 20/10 game requirement and all league games the deposit will be forfeited.
- Girls declarations are also due July 1st.

- Releases continue to come in. All programs are reminded that they must get a release for ALL new players.
- Preliminary rosters have been requested.
- Please review rosters and look at the release list posted to the CHC website. Players cannot be rostered unless a release has been obtained.
- SafeSport- all coaches, board members, volunteers must complete SafeSport every 2 years. Your registrar has a list of all those screened.

New England District/Team CT:

- Tom reported about Legal counsel at annual congress.
 - A conflict of interest policy is a yearly requirement. It will be presented in August.
 - USPHL has chosen to take all teams outside of USA Hockey at the Jr. Level.
 - Transgender Policy in progress
 - Playing rules- tag up off sides was defeated.
- New England District
 - Select 15 camp in progress
 - Select 14 will be held July 10-14 both in Keene NH
