

Waimak United FC - Senior Social team entry and payment policy (2015)

Social teams including Masters, Presidents grades, Lower Divisional grades, and Lower Women's grades will confirm their intention to enter a team into the Mainland leagues by **23th February 2015**. This should be emailed to waimakunited@xtra.co.nz and include the team managers name, address, contact ph no., and email address. Teams should also note their preferred grade and division, however this will be at the discretion of Mainland Football.

All players must register online at www.waimakunited.org.nz and pay a NON-REFUNDABLE \$25 registration fee. During this registration process players will be directed to also register in the NZ Football Goalnet registration database. Failure to be registered in these systems will make a player ineligible. All players are required to be in the Goalnet system by **31st March 2015**. **Note: players can be added at a later date and will be subject to the \$25 non-refundable registration fee as we will be charged this by MF & NZF in addition to previously invoiced fees.**

Only players registered in Goalnet may appear on a team sheet and take the field. In the interest of fairness of competitions & registered and financial players, both Mainland Football and our club will be ensuring adherence to this policy. All teams are required to send a signed (by both teams/referee) copy of their team sheet to our admin office, either by email to waimakunited@xtra.co.nz, or by pxt to 0211924625 before 6pm on Saturday afternoon, or 3pm Sunday afternoon for Sunday games.

On the **1st of April 2015**, teams will be invoiced for their team fee [= \$205 sub (as set at the 2014 AGM) x 16 players: \$3280 LESS \$25 x registered players] This payment is due by 5pm **9th April 2015** or the team will be withdrawn from the competition. Payment can be direct credited to the WUFC account: Westpac, Rangiora 03 0674 0240799 00 with the team name as a reference, or cash/cheque dropped to the upstairs office/or reception if after office hours at the Mega Sports Centre, 138 East Belt, Rangiora.

Please note under the new rules for player registration and eligibility etc teams will be responsible for all fines incurred and suspended until payment. See attached Fines Policy for full information.

Important Dates

23rd Feb – confirmation of intention to enter Mainland Leagues sent to Waimak admin

31st March – all players registered with WUFC and in the Goalnet system

1st April – team subscription invoice sent to manager via email address supplied

9th April – full payment of invoice required or team withdrawn from competition
