

**TO ALL HOCKEY PARTICIPANTS
(HOCKEY LEARN TO SKATE, HOCKEY DEVELOPMENT, HOUSE LEAGUE &
TRAVEL PARTICIPANTS)**

This season, all hockey participants from Hockey Learn to Skate, Development, House League and travel programs, will be required to register directly with USA Hockey. The online process is very simple, and it is outlined below. Players who fail to register will not be allowed to participate in any hockey program nor tryouts. Guide to Online Registration

The USA Hockey season goes from **September 1 through August 31** of each year.

Online registration for the 2010-11 season will be available starting May 1, 2010.

1. Go to www.usahockey.com. On the menu bar go to "Membership" and click on the "register, online" button, or you can find a direct link to USA Hockey through the Northern Lights website.
2. Choose member type Ice Player or Coach.
3. You must be 18 years of age to process a registration. Check the box that acknowledges that YOU are 18 or older.
4. **Select the correct season. USA Hockey will not refund fees.**
5. Follow the prompts...fill in all data correctly. **You must enter your child's name as it appears on their birth certificate. NO NICKNAMES**
6. Process payment – Visa, Master Card, Discover or American Express (credit or debit card). A Visa gift card can be used for payment if no credit card is available
7. **I suggest you enter my email as an alternate conf. page.** You may print your Confirmation page at this time. It will also be emailed to you immediately after the registration is completed if you don't enter my email for an extra conf. page. Once you receive the confirmation email from USA Hockey, **forward it to Allison Schulman allison2008@ymail.com**

USA Hockey Fees:

Each participant will pay the USA Hockey fee of \$30.

Players who live in CT will also pay the Connecticut Hockey Conference Affiliate fee of \$10.

Those of you who live in Mass. will pay the Mass. Youth Hockey fee. The USA Hockey Affiliate fee is determined by a player's residence, not by the state in which they play, and applies to all youth players regardless of age.

Additional information:

The home address should be used for all participants. If a player lives in one state and plays in another, enter the home address and pay any applicable Affiliate fee. The confirmation page/number will be accepted by any USA Hockey program in the country.

An email address is required.
