SKILLS TRAINING CLINIC FOR GIRLS

Entering the 15th summer of operation, Breakaway Hockey continues to provide high quality, age and skill appropriate hockey instruction. Breakaway Hockey focuses on the development of skills and self-confidence in a setting conducive to learning. Our Skills Training for Girls puts additional emphasis on developing and mastering skills relevant to the game of *girls* ice hockey. Girls who can shoot, pass and stickhandle have an opportunity to be standout players. Unlike men's hockey where size and physical play dominate, the game for women requires excellent skills.

SKILL GROUPING

Girls will initially be grouped based on age. Coaches will assess the skills of the players and re-group girls based on skill level. Please note that these clinics are *not* for beginners — they are intended for girls with previous hockey experience.

SPECIALIZED GOALIE TRAINING

Goalies will receive individualized instruction each day. Training will focus on strengthening skating and balance around the net, angles, rebounds and situational play. We will also explore the “mental” aspects of goaltending.

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be provided to store equipment overnight, eliminating the carting around of equipment each day.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

All players attending Breakaway Hockey's Skill Training For Girls will be expected to participate in supervised daily activities from 8:15 AM until 4:00 PM. These activities will take place from:

- ▶ Aug. 16th to 20th—ISCC, Simsbury

ON-ICE

All players will take the ice each morning at 8:30 AM. On-ice activities will focus on those skills critical to success in the game of *girls* ice hockey. Players who can master the skills often difficult for girls, such as shooting, pass control and puck control, will be in a much stronger position for long-term success.

- Three (3) one hour and 20 minute ice sessions per day.
- Four (4) hours of ice time daily.
- Focus on skill development *critical* to girls hockey .
 - ▶ Shooting
 - ▶ Passing
 - ▶ Puck Control
 - ▶ Stick Handling
 - ▶ Power Skating
 - ▶ Body Positioning
- Game Situation and Scrimmage.

OFF-ICE

All off-ice activities will be in support of activities to take place on-ice. This will allow for the most productive use of on-ice time.

- General Conditioning
