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## LYFS Awards 10 Scholarships Again in 2012!

LYFS is committed to academics and is proud to announce that it has awarded ten scholarships in total \$5,000 to former LYFS student-athletes (5 Male - 5 Female) who are graduating from high school in 2012 at the annual senior baccalaureate night on Thursday, June 14<sup>th</sup>.

The scholarships are in the names and memory of Warner Hale (**Panthers**), Christopher Fitzpatrick (**Jr. Lancers**) and Alex Lyskawa (**Wildcats**). Scholarships are funded through fundraising, primarily the annual Alex Lyskawa Memorial Golf Scramble and the monies are protected in a restricted scholarship account that is also pre-funded for 2013. LYFS has awarded over \$25,000 since 2006.

This year brought another record in applications (over 60), which are numbered and contain a good deal of information from academics, academic and other awards, clubs, teams & group activities, community & volunteer service, work experience and essays. The minimum criteria to be reviewed is that they must have been a student-athlete in LYFS for at least one year.

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## New Open Volunteer Positions:

### **Assistant Football Equipment Officer** (Posted June 18, 2012)

LYFS has a Board Opening for Assistant Football Equipment Officer for the 2012 season. Some of the primary functions of this position are:

The position works with the Football Equipment Officer and the Football Director to prepare for season by acquiring and bidding budgeted items such as equipment, first aid items, uniforms, etc. Assist in maintaining current assets and updating asset lists, maintain the facilities housing the assets and inventory and preparing items such as Coaches Bags in advance of season. This position is needed to carry out Equipment Pick-up and delivery at season end. In season coordination with the Football Equipment Officer to ensure coverage of the Football Shed at practice and prepare coaches needs for game day and practices. All officers are expected to attend majority of board meetings and assist with game day functions. Organization is a key trait for this position.

### **Public Relations Officer** (Posted June 8,2012)

LYFS has an Board Opening for Public Relations Director for the 2012 season. Some of the primary functions of this position are:

The Public Relations Director is a liaison between organization, parents and community and working with the Board of Directors to build and maintain communications internal and external to the organization such as: Football & Cheer Activities, Practices, Games & Fundraising Events. Public Relations works with local media, maintains and leads development of the Newsletter (EndZone Publication) and serves as the webmaster for the league website. Public Relations also reports scores, schedule & schedule changes. All officers are expected to attend majority of board meetings and assist in game day functions. Proficiency in base technology & marketing, microsoft office suite, email communications and adobe are basic requirements along with solid writing skills.
