

Tryout FAQ's

- 1) My child is already on a team, do they have to tryout again?
Yes all players must tryout for the new seasonal year. We realign the teams based on where is player is at this point.
- 2) Why is there a tryout fee?
Tryouts come with an expense to the club for the evaluators. Some clubs roll this into the fee for travel soccer. We feel that the cost should be shared by every player who attends tryouts, not just those who accept a place.
- 3) What if my child can only make one tryout?
One tryout is better than none. Those who attend two tryouts can have an off day and still get a chance to shine. We are looking for the best in players.
- 4) Is my child good enough to play travel soccer?
We have players of all different levels attend our tryouts every year. Some have played before and some have not. We encourage every player to tryout.
- 5) Who will evaluate the players in the tryouts?
Each player will be evaluated by three of our professional coaches.
- 6) When will be receive the results?
Each player will receive an e-mail on July 13th. The e-mail will either say "Congratulations we would like to offer you a place on our Team" or "at this point we cannot offer you a spot on a team and you have been placed on a waitlist". Please advise your child that there are two outcomes to the tryouts.
- 7) What if my child is trying out for a Premier team?
They should still register and tryout for Travel Soccer.
