Field Information

Grounds and Field Prep

- The fields at both Main and Commissioners are **not** in Game Ready condition. Our Ground Crew has worked on limited basis thus far to turn the Infields over and cut the grass. There is still work that will be completed in advance of the “Game Season” being played in late April and into May.

Post Practices and Games

- Please fill in the holes around the bases, home plate, and the mound before leaving after the final practice or game
- Rakes are in each Coaches Closet or Equipment Box
- Please ensure all Garbage is cleaned out of Dugouts after each practice or game
- Return all bases to the Closets or Equipment Boxes and install plugs at each base location after the final practice or game
- Tarps are subject to weather conditions. Once the game season starts, it is expected that Tarps are placed the home plate area and pitchers’ mound after the last game or practice unless otherwise directed by the Grounds Crew.
- When performing batting practice on fields with grass infields please do your best to throw and hit from mound and home plate areas. Pitching and hitting in the infield grass wears and kills it.
- Our game fields at Main and Commissioners Parks have a grass infield (exception Main E, C5 and C6) and with that the maintenance and upkeep take additional time and expense.
- FBB takes a lot pride in our fields and the Grounds Crews job is to protect the integrity of each field
- The Grounds Crew determines whether a field is playable- Managers, Coaches, Spectators, Parents, and Board Members do not. If the Grounds Crew states, the fields are not playable for any reason their decision is final.
- Please respect the decisions that are made during the season on field availability
- Pitchers Mounds- There are no temporary mound rubbers for any pitchers mounds. The lengths on each pitchers mounds are permanent- exception is C1 which has 2 locations. Do not install a temporary rubber on any pitchers mound

- Shetland | Instructional Levels – Sandalwood Subdivision, Commissioners C5-C6
- Pinto | 8U – Main E, Grande Prairie and Commissioners C2. (C2 has lights, but is a FGS and PD field 1st- permission needed to use)
- Mustang | 9U, 10U- Main D, Commissioners C4
- Bronco | 11U, 12U- Main B, Commissioners C3
- Pony | 13U, 14U and Up – Commissioners C1
- 14U and Up- Borg Warner Field @ Main Park
