Five Special Programs for 2012

All Programs are Sunday - Friday

Pee Wee Prep Training Camp

June 24-29 or July 8-13 or July 22-27

Ages 11 & 12 (as of December 31, 2012)

This program focuses on the development of basic skills, more advanced skills, and team concepts. The players are divided into six equally balanced teams. To better emphasize team concepts, a round robin tournament is held throughout the week, complimented by off-ice "Team Building". A personal evaluation along with **on and off-ice testing** is incorporated to help isolate strong and weak areas. A report of the test results is provided.

This is our most popular program.

Collegiate Development Training

July 1-6

Ages 15-18 (as of December 31, 2012)

All participants must still be in high school for the fall, 2012.

This program fills very quickly. It is a highly intense program designed to assist the player who is seeking to continue playing at the high school, junior or collegiate levels.

A **Fitness Profile** will be established on each student utilizing off-ice physiological tests such as leg strength, % of body fat, flexibility, grip strength, etc. in cooperation with **Miami's Athletic Training Center.**

Other features include plyometric training, on-ice testing, expanded team building, an individual hockey evaluation, and lectures on College Hockey and collegiate academic requirements.

All participants will receive an **NCAA Rules and Eligibility Guide** (if available), along with handouts on junior hockey and the college hockey recruiting process.

Due to the specialized nature of the program, enrollment is limited to 114 participants.

Most of the counselors within our Hockey Leadership Program for the summer of 2013 will be chosen from this program.

All Programs Include

On Ice Training

Daily Ice Time

Each student receives **4 ice sessions daily** beginning on Sunday evening with an ice session of demanding combination drills and station training. The 4 sessions are divided to work on the skills of skating, puck fundamentals, checking (where applicable), along with team play development, and a daily controlled instructional scrimmage. The use of station training and flow drills keeps participation and movement at a maximum.

Skating Dynamics and the Student's Development

Skating is the most important single skill in hockey. Our staff will use the most modern innovative teaching techniques, along with video tape replay on a **big screen monitor**, to improve posture, skating efficiency, stride, balance, arm movement, recovery, and more. The video tape is viewed immediately following the skating session.

Skills and Team Play

During the sessions each day, the athlete will be taken through a progression of skills in stickhandling, passing, shooting and checking as well as a variety of team play strategies. **All skills are taught in a position specific manner maximizing the benefits for the forwards and defensemen.**

Controlled Scrimmage

Each evening the players will participate in a controlled scrimmage with the coaches reinforcing the teaching of the day. On Friday afternoon each team will play a final match under game conditions. Teams and lines are properly "matched" to ensure the development of each participant. As the players age, the scrimmages become more competitive.

On Ice Testing

For those Pee Wee and older, tests are conducted with the results compared to norms established from the past. Players receive their results in their take-home packet.

The Goaltenders are Special

Goaltending is a game of situations. All great goaltenders have a strong fundamental base. Historically, goaltenders have had to make a choice on the type of summer program they attended. A "goaltender only program" stressed fundamentals with limited "mental development" and no actual game situations. A regular hockey school offered game situations, but provided goaltenders with limited attention. At Miami, a goaltender will receive **both**, and lots of attention.

Off-Ice Training

Daily Video Replay

Each player will get the chance to see him/herself execute the skating skill of the day on video on our big screen monitor, evaluated by our staff.

Bantam Advancement Training

June 17-22 or July 15-20

Ages 13 & 14 (as of December 31, 2012)

This camp is designed for **BANTAM age players, and those at this age level who may be playing high school hockey.**

Many aspects of both the "Pee Wee Prep" and the "College Development Camp" will be encompassed in this program. **Each participant receives 4 ice sessions daily.**

The players are divided into six teams emphasizing fundamentals, more advanced team concepts, a daily round robin tournament game, and further instruction into the proper techniques of **giving and taking checks**, which becomes even more important as players mature.

We lecture on the importance of mixing academics with athletics, emphasizing the "hockey ladder" and the options available to a player as he develops and ages.

Along with a personal evaluation, **on and off-ice tests** are conducted to help isolate strong and weak areas.

Pre-Checking Camp

June 10-15

Ages 8-10 (as of December 31, 2012)

The pre-check camp is designed to emphasize the individual hockey skills and primary team play concepts in an enthusiastic, fun, yet very structured, safe atmosphere. Angling rather than checking is introduced.

The camp is divided into groups, organized by age, experience and ability. Each group is supervised by 3-4 leadership counselors and coached by two instructors.

Besides hockey, it is a great "life experience". Our staff does a great job with young hockey players away from home for the first time.

All participants receive **4 ice sessions daily**, daily video taping and a personalized evaluation at the conclusion of the week.

Girls Development

PRETEEN

June 24-29

Ages 8-12 (as of December 31, 2012)

TEEN

July 1-6

Ages 13-18 (as of December 31, 2012)

The Girls development camp is designed to emphasize the individual hockey skills and primary team play concepts while taking into account the difference between ability levels. **All concepts will be taught in an enthusiastic, structured, and safe atmosphere.**

The camp will be divided into 4 teams based on age and experience to give all participants the best possible chance to learn in their appropriate ability level. Each team will have 2 counselors and coached by 2 instructors.

All players get 4 ice sessions daily, classroom sessions, videotaping, and personalized skating evaluation at the conclusion of camp. The camp also provides unique off-ice activities utilizing Miami's Recreation Sports Center. In addition to hockey, we pride ourselves on providing a great camp experience. Our staff does a great job with young hockey players who are away from home for the first time.

Daily Lecture Sessions

Each group/team will have a daily session including the use of specifically developed NHL and collegiate game highlight instructional tapes, along with team and individual concepts, rules, sportsmanship, systems and the avenues of combining higher education with ice hockey.

Off-Ice Block Upgraded!

The daily off ice-ice block continues to evolve to inspire, challenge, educate, or just allow the players to "unwind". Activities, which vary daily and by program, include:

Two Options to Register

Payment Plan

Miami Hockey School will now offer a payment plan consisting of two payments. 1st payment of \$300 will be at time of registration and is subject to our normal cancellation policy (below). Remainder of balance will be charged to the credit card given on May 1st 2012. **Only on-line registration will be eligible for payment plan.** All other payment options will be required to pay full amount of camp at time of registration.

Online

Due to multiple requests we will now offer online registration for Miami Hockey School. Please visit our website at miamihockeyschool.com and follow the instructions. Please remember you must have a valid credit card to register online and full payment is taken immediately. Online registration is on a first come first serve basis taking into account all mail in registration.

Mail

You may also register by mail. Please mail your application, with full payment to the address on the application form. We do require full payment upon receiving your application to register your player in camp. You may pay with a check or credit card (Visa or MasterCard). Mail in registration is on a first come first serve basis taking into account all online registration.

Cancellation policy

-Up to the day before a camp begins, all fees paid, less the \$100.00 administrative fee, are refundable in full if a **medical reason or summer school requirement exists.** In both cases, a written statement from a doctor or school Principal must be presented to the Miami University Hockey School Office. In the case of a summer school requirement, notification must be made to the Hockey School Office prior to June 10. A withdrawal for any other reason must be in writing prior to the Sunday start of camp and will receive **a refund of unused room and board only.** Any other special circumstance prior to the start of a camp must be brought to the attention of the Director of the Hockey Camp.

-After a camp begins, registrants who must leave camp for medical, personal, or disciplinary reasons will receive a refund of **the unused portion of room and board only.** No portion of the instructional fee will be refunded.

-Your roommate's failure to get into our program is not a satisfactory grounds for cancellation.

Other Related Information

Check-in time is between 2:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Eastern Time (boys) and between 3:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. Eastern Time (girls). First meal served will be dinner on Sunday evening. Last meal will be lunch for all camps on Fridays. Commuters will join the camp after breakfast, and must stay with us all day.

Age Breakdown... Meeting The Rules

Our goal is for every student to play within the level he/she will play **NEXT** season. Therefore, all age grouping will be based on the **December 31, 2012** date used by USA Hockey for classification.

Equipment Needed

All players including goaltenders must provide and properly wear their own full legal equipment (helmets, pads, sticks, gloves, etc.). Our Pro Shop is well stocked to handle most of your needs. For your convenience, a Pro Shop charge account may be set up at registration to accommodate the player's needs during the week. We supply the jersey, sponsored by **Reebok/CCM.**

Roommates

A roommate request is your preference. We will make every effort to accommodate the request. To be valid, **both** roommates should request each other. One request, please. All roommates play on the same team. Multiple requests cannot be honored.

Any accidents or illness will be treated at the Miami University Health Service or at McCullough-Hyde Memorial Hospital near campus. Our medical form is available on our website for each participant to print. A medical and liability release statement including vital medical information is included on this form. It must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian and brought to registration. No youngster may participate without turning in this completed form.
