

# Out of Town Players

It is strongly recommended by the NYHL Board of Directors that all out of town players continue to play for their local programs. We do not encourage players from outside of the City of Newburyport to play for our program though we realize that in certain instances players have no other choice.

All new players that are not residents of the City of Newburyport looking to gain entry into the NYHL must provide the league with a justifiable reason for your moving to our program. A letter of good standing will be required from new out of town players.

Players from other programs that are granted permission to play for the NYHL are subject to Mass Hockey rules, specifically Article 1 Section D, which states that “a city or town program may register and roster up to three (3) members per roster who are non-residents provided such member does not have outstanding financial obligations to another Massachusetts Hockey or USA Hockey affiliated program.” The NYHL Board of Directors has the final say in the placement of all out of town players. Any player not able to play due to the NYHL’s compliance with Article 1, Section D of the Mass Hockey Rules and Regulations will be provided with a full refund of registration and tuition payments made to date.
