



## ***CALL-UP RULES***

*Effective Date: November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017*

### ***Call Ups:***

1. Players may only be called up one level (e.g.: Pony > Minors, or Minors > Majors)
2. Players may never be called down a level

### ***Call Up Situations:***

1. Prior notice - the coach may contact the call up coordinator(s) to fill empty spot(s) in the roster
2. Short notice - if a coach was not notified about a late arriving player and does not have 9 players to fill his roster prior to game time, he/she may contact a coordinator to fill roster spot(s)

### ***Game Situations:***

1. Player called up may NEVER pitch
2. Player called up must bat last in the order
  - Exception - player called up may bat before a player who arrives late for a game
3. A regular rostered player may not sit more innings than a call up
4. Player called up MUST sit at least one inning, but must also comply with the league 'playing time' rules

### ***Call Up List:***

1. Pony and Minor player call ups will be determined at the draft by the head coaches. Colt players call ups will be determined by the Colts head coaches, picking 2-3 players that have the ability to play up and supply the coordinator with player contact info.
2. The Call Up List will be sorted in order of: first player submitted; alphabetical order of team
3. After being called up, the player goes to the bottom of the list
4. Coordinators are to keep records of call ups to use for evaluation of system in the off season
