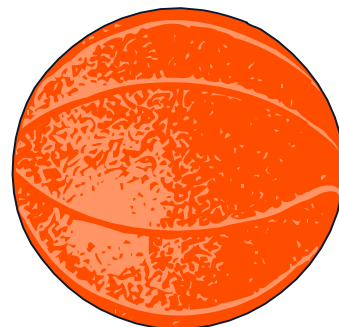

The Elite Girls Basketball Camp Directors

A standout guard during her career at Stonehill College, **Kristen Morast Clark** helped lead the Skyhawks to their first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II "Elite Eight" I in 1994. One of the top backcourt scorers for Stonehill throughout her career, Kristen ranked among the leaders in both scoring and assists in the Northeast-10 during her senior season, and her skills in guiding the offense as well as being a top threat helped key the Skyhawk attack. A noted clinician Kristen will instruct campers on the fundamentals of offensive play, including ball-handling and distribution, shooting, fast break offense and other drills that will help build the skills level of young players throughout their development.

One of the top defensive stalwarts during her career at Stonehill, **Cheryl Tebou Seavey** helped lead the Skyhawks to three appearances in the NCAA Division II tournament. Usually the one to draw the toughest defensive assignments, Cheryl was one of the leading rebounders for the Skyhawks at both ends of the floor. Cheryl, who has served on the coaching staffs at both Whitman-Hanson and Middleboro High Schools, also serves as the Travel Team Coordinator for Bridgewater Girls Basketball as a member of its Board of Directors. She will provide instruction to campers on the defensive aspect of the game including rebounding, footwork and containment.
