**I. Call to Order**

Fundraiser calendars had a 97% return rate. Total received was \$7,470 less expenses and prizes paid \$2,334 the profit was \$5,136.

Stephen Marshall informed the Board that tuition rates will be staying the same.

**VI. 2018-2019 Registration, Tryout and Tuition Fee Schedule**
