Review/Approval of Minutes from last Meeting (9/12)

- Dawn made a motion to accept the minutes of the 9/12 meeting, Maureen seconded the motion, all were in favor.

Golf Ball Drop Fundraiser Review

- Event itself went well. Had 30 players attend. Prizes were too high. Although we brought in over \$6K our net was approximately \$1K after all expenses.
- Donated gift cards were extremely helpful in covering overhead cost. T-shirts were not included in the event expenditures.
- Rich made a motion to sell the remaining T-shirts at the Randolph Rink Pro Shop. Dawn seconded the motion, all were in favor

Future Fundraising

- Halfway Café Kick Back night – scheduled for Sunday 11/10/13 – league will get 10 – 20% back on all purchases. Patron must present coupon in order for the league to get issued credit. Chrissy to provide coupons to Blaire to post to the website and Facebook page. Discussed distributing to LTS parents week before the event in addition to placing flyers on cars in the rink parking lot.
- Canning – Chrissy to look into league opportunities. Cannot schedule anything in Randolph through the end of the year – plus we need to obtain updated Certificate from the State. Dawn to contact AG's office to inquire.

LTS / LTP

- First impression – initial class went well. LTP had approx. 25 – 30 players on the ice.
- Rich to talk to Blaire about sending email blast to participants regarding registration and payment for additional 8 weeks.
- Need to have Cassie put together program for on ice assistants so they know what to do with the LTS participants.
- Moved a few players into our Mite program.
- Discussed prorated tuition for those players.
- Discussed pictures for LTP participants – and decided this should be offered during the second session as these would be the more committed players.



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Holiday Party

- Would like to find a sponsor to give holiday gift to each participant – ie. Cyclones skate towel.
- Will look to ask rink for use of the snack bar – hot chocolate machine
- Ask participants to bring baked goods.
- Possibly get pizza donation from Avon House of Pizza.

- Holiday music to be played over the Commonwealth Figure Skating Sound System.
- Discussed offering participation to PeeWee and under teams – need to discuss options further.

Teams Requesting Away Jerseys

- It was decided for uniformity to only offer one option for the white “away” jersey. NSF Concepts provided a quote of \$54.75 per jersey fully dressed – includes sponsor on the back of the jersey. Teams can look to find team level sponsors to help offset the cost of the jersey. Fundraising at the team level needs to be discussed further...one thought was a 50/50 split for canning proceeds. Issue has been tabled for further discussion.
