

2010 Player Evaluation Schedule [REVISED 2/7/10]

All registered **13-15 year old players** must participate in the Player Evaluations. Players are encouraged to attend both of their scheduled evaluation sessions. Each participant will receive an overall evaluation rating and, if desired, a pitcher and/or catcher evaluation rating. These ratings will be used to place players on Prep, Warriors and AAA teams and be taken into consideration by Majors teams and when inviting players to tournament team tryouts.

Players should dress in appropriate baseball practice attire. It is recommended that players wear sweat or baseball pants, a long sleeve shirt, baseball or tennis shoes, and a baseball cap. Players should bring an extra layer (shirt or sweatshirt) in case it is cold in the dome. Players should also bring their baseball glove, helmet and bat. A few old bats and helmets will be available for players that don't have their own or don't want to risk damaging their own bats.

All sessions are held at the **Tonka Dome**. Players should arrive 10-15 minutes prior to their start time to check in and warm-up.
