



What are the fees and what do they cover?

Club Fees include over 128 hours of professional training, professional coaching, and games; they also cover all operational club expenses as detailed below:

| 10 outdoor league games in each Fall and Spring seasons - 20 hours |

| 10 - 12 weeks of indoor training (1.25 hour per week minimum) and FUTSAL (indoor house league) - 20 hours |
| 1 Fall tournament and 1 Spring tournament - 6 hours (10 for boys teams including seeding tournament) |
| Full Time Professional Game Coaching |
| NISL / IWSL League Fees |
| Referee and Linesmen Fees |
| Park District fees (nets, field maintenance, lights, etc) |
| Club operational costs (Director of Coaching, soccer equipment, staff equipment, Financial Statement audit, mailings, copies, advertisement, credit card fees, etc) |

Fees vary from team-to-team. **TESC is committed in having all trainings sessions and games coached by a full time staff coach.** At additional costs, teams have the opportunity to play an indoor league and extra tournaments during the season. All players can attend extra training sessions, GK sessions, and Street Soccer at **no additional cost.**

The Boys fees are higher due to the NISL (boys league) mandatory preseason seeding tourney which takes place in August.

These fees are an estimate and [the actual fees](#) will be determined after rosters are finalized for the 2010-2011 playing season.

Please note, the \$500.00 deposit is due by registration night via the on-line system with the remainder of team fees due on or near August 19, 2010, October 26, 2010, and January 2, 2011, for the upcoming playing season. Following the deposit, the remaining fees will be divided into three payments as per the above schedule. Players will not be able to play in the upcoming season if their fees are not paid. Fees are based on a year-round commitment from both the parents and child.
