### BURBANK ICE ARENA ZAMBONIS LEAD THE BRUINS TO FENWAY

On Friday, December 18, 2009 two Zamboni machines from the Burbank Ice Arena helped the Boston Bruins open the ice rink at Fenway Park. The machines led the Bruins Legends caravan from the TD Garden to Fenway Park as the current team prepared for its January 1<sup>st</sup> Winter Classic game against the Philadelphia Flyers..

Bruins legends including Bobby Orr, Ken Hodge, Ed Sanford, Gary Doak, Milt Schmidt and many more enjoyed a pre-parade reception. The legends then boarded “Beantown Trolleys” emblazoned “follow us to Fenway” while Burbank Arena General Manager Ed Peduto drove the Burbank’s 1958 Model F Zamboni, the 134<sup>th</sup> made, onto Causeway Street toward Boston City Hall. The caravan continued on to Kenmore Square, where Burbank Asst. Manager Jim Brown had the honor of leading the legends over the Mass Turnpike, onto Lansdowne Street and into center field of Fenway.

The legends officially opened Fenway’s arena while Brown & Peduto received a tour of Fenway, including the ice making machinery for the Winter Classic.
