



Hanover Hockey Association Financial Aid Policy

Limited funds are available annually to assist families for whom HHA registration fees pose a hardship. Financial assistance will be only be provided for HHA annual registration fees and not for other costs associated with hockey participation, such as travel and equipment. Alternative payment plans are also an option and may be arranged by contacting the Registrar.

Families interested in requesting financial aid should contact the HHA Registrar early in the registration process. Financial aid application forms will be provided and must be submitted by an August 1 deadline.

A committee consisting of the Registrar, Treasurer and a third Board member appointed by the President shall review all submitted applications and, in their sole and absolute discretion, render financial aid decisions. If one of the committee members represents a family applying for assistance, this member shall be replaced by another Board member.

The committee is authorized to award financial aid up to an amount approved by the Board during the annual budget process plus any available funds earmarked for this purpose through fundraising efforts. The committee is not required to award all available funds and may reserve financial aid funds for future use. All awards shall be made by September 1. Any requests made after the August 1 deadline, including requests for players in HHA's introductory hockey programs, shall be considered after the initial review and are limited to the remaining available funds.
