

Tournament Weather Guidelines

These guidelines are a precaution to ensure the safety of everyone at the tournament. Adults and Parents/Guardians must take responsibility for the safety of children in their care. The Kickers Soccer Club recommends everyone to take shelter in a safe place or location designed to protect from weather related dangers.

Take Shelter Signal:

The Kickers Soccer Club requires immediate evacuation of all practice and game fields after bad weather threats are signaled or anticipated. In the event that lightning or other related danger is approaching the Stuart Sports Complex during the tournament, we will sound the "Take Shelter" signal, indicated by the 1 (one) long blast of an air horn.

All Clear Signal

The "All Clear" signal will be 2 (two) short blasts from an air horn and will indicate when play may resume and will indicate when thirty minutes has passed since the last observation of thunder.
