Code of Conduct - Athlete and Coach

1. I will not use profanity.
2. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all athletes, coaches, and officials at every meet and practice.
3. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my teammates and opponents ahead of my personal desire to win.
4. I will treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed or ability.
5. I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol.
6. I will do my best to remember that youth sports are supposed to be FUN and that winning and losing are part of everyone's experience.
7. I will express my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner.
8. I will respect the volunteers that are assisting with the conduct of these events.

Code of Conduct - Parents

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all athletes, coaches, and officials at every meet and practice.
2. I will place the emotional and physical well being of the athletes ahead of my personal desire to win.
3. I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all EPTFA sporting events.
4. I will remember that the game is for the kids - not the adults.
5. I will do my best to make sure that youth sports are a FUN and POSITIVE experience.
6. I will treat other players, coaches, fans, volunteers and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
7. I will not berate the officials.
