# A Letter from the President of Pittsford Little League

I want to welcome you to our 58<sup>th</sup> year of Little League Baseball in Pittsford, NY. We have made many exciting changes over the past few years. Our fees continue to be less than nearly all other youth sports, and the value remains higher than ever.

The most notable change is online registration, and all of the benefits offered by it. Below you will find instructions for registering. Registration in-person is no longer required. Go online to [www.PittsfordLittleLeague.org](http://www.PittsfordLittleLeague.org), click on Registration, and log in by using your email address. No lines, no checks, no forms. Over 400 players registered online in Fall 2009.

Other recent developments include the formation of a Challenger Division for youth in need of a little extra help in playing the game, the expansion of the team draft to younger players, and the option of all-girl teams for the younger leagues. We have expanded our Player Development program and include Baseball and Softball clinics at four venues.

As always, we will continue the services we provide the community of over 1100 boys and girls, and look forward to many years to come. We encourage you to join in the spirit that is Pittsford Little League.

## Registration Process:

1. From the home page, if there is an open registration available, the site will automatically display a "Register Online" selection. If you were emailed a link directly to a registration and did not start here, skip down to step [#3](#).
2. Once you have selected Register Online, you will be presented with a list of all open registration programs for the club. This page will include a brief overview of the available programs. Select the program by clicking the "Register" button.
3. Once clicked, the system will provide a brief explanation of who can register for the program. If the program is open to minors, either a parent or guardian over the age of 18 will have to register the minor.
4. After you have read the restriction disclaimer and clicked "Continue", you will be prompted for an email address and password. If you are a **NEW** member, then only enter your email address and the system will send you a temporary password. If you are an **EXISTING** member, then enter the email address and password that you previously created. If you have forgotten your password, enter your email address and the system will send it to you.
5. After your email address and password has been verified, for **NEW** members the system will start to gather the necessary information for registration. If the program is open to minors - the system will start by gathering the **GUARDIAN (YOUR)** information. This form includes **NAME, ADDRESS, HOME (REQUIRED)/WORK/CELL TELEPHONE NUMBERS and EMAIL ADDRESS**. At the bottom of the form, the member will also have the option to add a second guardian

If you are an **EXISTING** member, you will be presented with a Family screen that shows each member of you family. If a family member is eligible for the selected Registration program, the system will display a **"REGISTER"** button next to the family member's name. If the member is not eligible for the program, than the word **"INELIGIBLE"** will appear.

6. Once either the Guardian information has been entered or an eligible family member has been selected, the system will request the **PARTICIPANT'S** information. If this is an EXISTING member, all of the information will already be filled in; however, it can be edited if any information has changed. If the participant is a NEW member than the form will be pre-filled with the same information as the Guardian, with the exception of the first name and middle initial. Any of the pre-filled information can be changed if necessary. The Participant's **DATE OF BIRTH and GENDER** will also need to be entered.
7. Once the Participant Information has been submitted, you will then be asked to fill out any additional required information.

After the form has been completed, the system will return a Review page. This page will confirm that the form has been filled out correctly. If a payment is due you will be given either an address to send payment to and/or a **"Pay Now"** button to pay electronically in a secure environment. You may also opt to **"Register Another Individual"** which will bring you back to the Register Online page. **Payment can be made for all family members at the same time. REGISTRATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL PAYMENT HAS BEEN RECEIVED BY PITTSFORD LITTLE LEAGUE.**

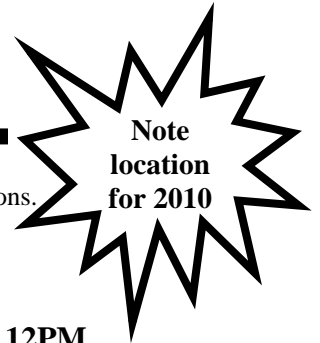
We will also have two Open Houses to assist you in registering online and to answer any of your questions. Unlike past years, you **do not** need to attend the open house to register.

**Open House** at Pittsford Mendon High School Commons

When: **Wednesday, January 20<sup>th</sup>, 6PM – 9PM & Saturday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 9AM – 12PM**

**Registration Fee Schedule:** Per official Little League Rules, the player's age is determined as follows:

- If the player is playing **baseball**, it is the player's age on **April 30, 2010**
- If the player is playing **softball**, it is **December 31, 2009**

**Please note the registration fees are unchanged for 2010 – our fifth straight year of no fee increases!!!**

There is a \$40 fee reduction for the third (and all subsequent) player(s) registered in each family; the lower cost fees are the ones reduced. If in need of financial assistance, please contact David Hester, PLL President (contact info below).

### **Late Registrations:**

A **\$30 late charge** will be added to all registrations received after **January 25<sup>th</sup>**. Please see our website at [www.pittsfordlittleleague.org](http://www.pittsfordlittleleague.org) for how to submit a late registration form after January 25<sup>th</sup>. Late registrants may be placed on a waiting list, and we may not be able to address special requests regarding team placement. Residents new to the area will not be charged a late fee.

### **Refund Policy:**

**12 & under:** 100% refund if written request postmarked on or before March 1st, or if an email is received by a current board member on or before **March 1<sup>st</sup>**. No refunds after this date unless accompanied by a doctor's medical excuse.

**13 & over:** 100% refund if written request postmarked on or before April 1st, or if an email is received by a current board member on or before **April 1<sup>st</sup>**. No refunds after this date unless accompanied by a doctor's medical excuse.

Please note that all refund checks will not be processed and mailed until around May 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Proof of Age:**

All new players to Pittsford Little League must provide, at the time of registration, a photocopy of proof of age, (i.e. birth certificate or passport). This will be kept on file as the player's official proof of age. Players who have played in prior years sometimes may need to provide proof of age if not on file. Scanned images can be uploaded to the website or mailed in (PLL, PO Box 313, Pittsford NY 14534) separately.

**Residency Requirements:**

Players must reside within the geographic boundaries of the Pittsford Central School District to be eligible. Please contact David Hester at [PittsfordLLPresident@gmail.com](mailto:PittsfordLLPresident@gmail.com) for questions about residency.

**Registration Form:**

Registration is done online. Secure payment can be made with credit card. The registration process retains information from year to year, making the process simple. Assistance with online registration will also be available at the two Open Houses.

**VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:** As a condition of enrollment, parents/guardians are **expected** to make a volunteer commitment to the league. Please commit to one of the following at Registration:

**Manager** - Overall responsibility for player and team development; organizes and makes game decisions with assistance from coaches.

**Coach** - Assists manager at games and practices.

**Opening Day** - Traffic Control, Photo Session Assistants and Parade Organizers. Opening Day is scheduled for Saturday, May 1st. Please contact David Hester at [PittsfordLLPresident@gmail.com](mailto:PittsfordLLPresident@gmail.com).

**Grounds Maintenance:** Maintain PLL facilities during the season. Schedule will vary based on availability.

**Board Positions:** Various openings exist to help the League throughout the year.

**Special Events:** Barbeque, Picnics, Tournament are always in need of volunteers.

**Regular Season:**

Regular season games for most leagues will begin in early May, and will end by early July. Please see the 2010 General Information on Leagues section.

**Summer Tournament and Second Season Teams:**

Information on PLL summer Tournament teams and the 2010 Fall Leagues will be provided during the spring season. Tournament teams represent all of Pittsford and play against teams from other towns in July and possibly August. National teams comprise the highest level of play. State teams remain within New York, and local tournaments are restricted to the greater Rochester area. Teams are separated by age and tryouts are conducted for player selection. There is an additional cost per player to participate in tournament play.

# 2010 - General Information on "Leagues"

This provides a brief overview of each "League" PLL expects to have in 2010, based on player registration. You can obtain more detail by visiting our web site at [www.pittsfordlittleleague.org](http://www.pittsfordlittleleague.org), or from any PLL representative at the open house sessions.

- Ages shown are "Little League Ages". Per official Little League rules, the player's age is determined as follows:  
>> For **baseball**, it is the player's age on **April 30, 2010** >> For **softball**, it is the player's age on **December 31, 2009**  
There can be no exceptions to this age requirement. This is a national Little League regulation; PLL cannot alter it.
- **Baseball** is open to **boys and girls**. **Softball** is chartered for **girls only**.
- Time/location for any leagues requiring evaluations will be available online

## **BASEBALL LEAGUE DESCRIPTIONS (open to Boys and Girls):**

### **Tee - Ball (5 Year Old & 6 Year Old)**

- There is a separate 5 year old Tee-Ball league and 6 year old Tee-Ball League
- Both leagues are instructional. Teams usually formed by neighborhood and/or school.
- If indicated by the parent at registration, all-girl teams may be formed, but this cannot be guaranteed, and is not mandatory

### **Instructional Leagues (7 Year Old & 8 Year Old)**

- Teams usually formed by neighborhood and/or school, but this cannot be guaranteed.
- If indicated by the parent at registration, all-girl teams may be formed, but this cannot be guaranteed, and is not mandatory
- Coaches pitch (batting tee may be used in some circumstances) with players batting until the ball is hit.
- "Soft" – Reduced Injury baseballs are used. Emphasis on development of fundamental skills.

### **"A" League Baseball (8 & 9 Year Old)**

- Teams usually formed by neighborhood, school, and/or prior team members, **but this cannot be guaranteed**.
- Players pitch; players can "strike out".
- There will be a limited number of 8 year olds drafted onto A teams, based on an evaluation held in March. 8 year olds who wish to be considered for A League must attend the single designated evaluation.
- League will focus on developing pitching and catching skills and learning fundamentals of competitive baseball.

### **"AA" League Baseball (9 & 10 Year Old)**

- 12 players per team. Players are drafted to balance competitiveness of the League, **not by neighborhood or school**.
- There will be a limited number of 9 year olds drafted onto AA teams, based on evaluations held in March. 9 year olds who wish to be considered for AA League must attend these evaluations.
- 10 year old players not selected by a AAA team will be drafted onto a AA team; 10 Year olds **MUST** attend evaluations.
- This is a competitive league; scores and standings will be kept.

### **"AAA" League Baseball (10 & 11 Year Old)**

- 12 players per team. Players "drafted" to balance competitiveness of the League, **not by neighborhood or school**.
- All 10 & 11 year olds **MUST** attend evaluations. 11 year old players not selected by a majors team will be drafted into AAA.
- This is a competitive league; scores and standings will be kept.

### **Major League Baseball (11 & 12 Year Old)**

- This is our most competitive under 12 baseball league, twelve players per team.
- **With limited exceptions** all 12 year olds will play in the majors.
- ALL 11 year old players and 12 year old players who were not on a Major League team in 2009 **MUST** attend evaluations.

### **Junior League Baseball (13 Year Old & 14 Year Old)**

- Teams from Pittsford **MAY** compete in a "District League" against teams from other towns in Monroe County
- All 13 year olds and all non-returning players **MUST** attend evaluations. Players will be "drafted" onto a Junior team.
- 14 year olds may be eligible for the Senior League based on registration #s. GM will make final determination.
- Players **MAY** participate in other programs during the National Tournament

### **Senior League Baseball (15 Year Old & 16 Year Old)**

- Teams from Pittsford compete in a "District League" against teams from other towns in Monroe County.
- Non-returning players **MUST** attend evaluations. Draft to be held after evaluations.
- Practices usually start in early May, and season usually ends in early July.
- Players **MAY** participate in other programs during the National Tournament

### **Big League Baseball (17 Year Old & 18 Year Old)**

- Teams from Pittsford compete in a "District League" against teams from other towns in Monroe County.
- Number of teams determined by number of players who register. Games usually from late June – August.

## **SOFTBALL LEAGUE DESCRIPTIONS (open to Girls only):**

### **Instructional League Softball (7 & 8 Year Olds)**

- Small team rosters. Teams usually formed by neighborhood and/or school, **but this cannot be guaranteed.**
- Coaches pitch (batting tee may be used in some circumstances) with players batting until ball is hit.
- Reduced-injury ("soft") balls are used. Emphasis on development of fundamental skills.

### **"AA" League Softball (9 & 10 Year Olds)**

- Teams formed by neighborhood, school and/or prior team members, **but cannot be guaranteed.**

### **"AAA" League Softball (10 & 11 Year Olds)**

- 11-12 players per team. Teams will be formed by a draft (**not by neighborhood or school**) to balance competitiveness.
- Any 10 year old interested in playing in AAA league **MUST** attend evaluations, *no exceptions.*
- 10 year olds that are not drafted onto a AAA team will be placed on a AA team.
- This league will focus on continuing development of players, especially pitching and catching.

### **Major League Softball (11 & 12 Year Olds)**

- All 12 year olds will play in the Major league. 10 year olds will be allowed to try-out for this league.
- *ASA players are encouraged to sign up w/ PLL. Efforts will be made to avoid game conflicts between the leagues.*

# 2010 Pittsford Little League Baseball and Softball Player Development Program



**New Options for Player Development!** There is no shortage of opportunities to develop your baseball and softball skills, and get ready for Opening Day. Varsity Softball and Baseball Clinics are once again being offered. Proceeds from the High School programs will be donated to their booster clubs. Each of the high schools offer great coaching, hitting tunnels and great equipment for indoor training. We also have our Frozen Ropes programs back for a sixth straight year and new offerings for 2010 at both RIT and The Battery. We encourage all participants to attend at least one clinic, or as many as you like.

Learn the fundamentals of the game and have fun!

**Baseball:**

High School Baseball Clinics: Mendon and Sutherland Baseball clinics will be held on Sundays in March. Varsity coaches and players will conduct an all-skills clinic focusing on boys 9&10 and 11&12. These are great opportunities to build program morale and show off for your High School coaches! Please register for the clinic offered by **YOUR** High School program. (Mendon = MHS, Sutherland = SHS)

Rochester Institute of Technology Clinics: New this year, RIT Baseball's Coaching Staff and Players will focus on ages 5&6 and 7&8 with 5 sessions of instruction in Throwing, Infield/Outfield, Hitting, and Base Running. Experience RIT's facilities and College level instruction. All proceeds benefit RIT Baseball.

Frozen Ropes Baseball Clinics: Each clinic is \$100 for 5 sessions of training encompassing Academy-style and 'The 5 Tool Player'. Pitching and Catchers Clinics are offered as well. Clinics are staggered so players can build their skills throughout the winter months.

**Softball:**

Frozen Ropes Softball Spring Training: Consists of five 1-hour sessions on Sunday afternoons. Players will be divided into smaller groups by age at the clinic. Each program costs \$100 for 5 hours of training.

High School Softball Clinics: The Varsity coaches and players will conduct all-skills clinics over three consecutive Saturdays focusing on girls ages 7-12 (Mendon in January, Sutherland in March). Players may attend both clinics if they wish. The Sutherland Softball Clinic is new for 2010.

The Battery Softball Academy: Also new this year, The Battery training complex (1520 Spencerport Rd, Rochester) will conduct an all-skills softball clinic over six consecutive Saturdays (90 minutes each day). Girls age 8-12 are welcome.
