Restart	Center draw after each goal. When a shot is blocked by the shot blocker and ends up in the crease, a defender enters the crease and continues play.	Center draw after each goal.

Substitution	After a goal, on the fly, or on stoppage of play.		After a goal or on the fly.

NOTES:

- Offensive 3 seconds: Holding the ball for more than 3 seconds when closely guarded/marked and the defense has both hands on her stick and is in position to legally check were checking allowed (i.e. modified or full checking rules) results in a change of possession.
- 3 Pass Rule: The pass count resets with the change of possession, including when the goalie makes a save and retains control of the ball. Umpires are responsible for counting passes.
