The Home Run Card

The League continues its ***Field Improvement Fund*** to support the continuing refurbishment of fields and building of new fields. ***The Home Run Card*** will be a major fund-raiser for this Fund. Each player will purchase two \$5.00 Cards included in the \$70 registration fee. The player may sell these valuable discount cards and keep the proceeds of the sale. This provides each player the opportunity to participate in the development of facilities which all will enjoy.

Girls Junior League Program: How it works

The Girls Junior Softball League includes some 13 and all 14 year old players. Junior Team assignment is based on tryouts and a selection process. The Junior League Team plays in a District 7 travel league with neighboring towns. (Wethersfield, Rocky Hill, West Hartford, East Hartford, Hartford, Newington) 13 year old players that do not get selected to the Juniors team will participate in the major league division.

Playing Fields

A 14-16 game schedule is planned for the season. Home games will be played on weekdays and weekends at Academy and GHS. Away games are played in neighboring towns.

Important Girls Junior League Playing Rules

In an effort to provide a beneficial softball experience to all Girls Junior League players, the following minimum playing rules are in effect. Players, parents and coaches are urged to take note of the following playing rules.:

- 1. No player shall play one inning more than any other player in a game. Please advise your coach if you are going to miss a game as this rule requires pre-game planning***
- 2. All players are placed in the batting order, The batting order is rotated one position every game***
- 3. No player shall sit on the bench for consecutive innings.***
- 4. Every player shall play at least two defensive inning(6 outs) at an infield position. The Pitcher and Catcher positions shall be considered infield positions.***
- 5. Adult coaches are not allowed on the field during the course of the games***

All 14 year olds MUST attend the two scheduled tryout. Failure to do so may jeopardize placement on a team.
