

# **2010 Glastonbury Little League**

## **Girls Majors Softball League Division**

### ***The Home Run Card***

The League continues its **Field Improvement Fundraising** to support the continuing refurbishment of fields and building of new fields. **The Home Run Card** will be a major fund-raiser for this Fund. Each player will purchase two \$5.00 Cards included in the \$70 registration fee. The player may sell these valuable discount cards and keep the proceeds of the sale. This provides each player the opportunity to participate in the development of facilities which all will enjoy.

### ***Girls Majors League Program: How it works***

The Girls Majors Softball League is designed for 11-13 year old players. Some 13 year olds may be assigned to the Juniors Division. Assignment to teams is based on tryouts and a selection process.. The number of teams and total number of positions available is dependant on the registration level.

### ***Playing Fields***

A 14-16 game schedule is planned for the season. Away games if any, will be played in neighboring towns. Home games will be played on weekdays and weekends at Addison 2 and Hebron Ave School fields with a round robin planned for Academy Field.

### ***Important Girls Majors League Playing Rules***

In an effort to provide a beneficial softball experience to all Girls Major League players, the following playing rules are in effect. Players, parents and coaches are urged to take note of the following:

- 1. No player shall play one inning more than any other player in a game. Please advise your coach if you are going to miss a game as this rule requires pre-game planning***
- 2. All players are placed in the batting order regardless of whether they are playing a defensive position***
- 3. No player shall sit on the bench for consecutive innings.***
- 4. The batting order will be set for the season. Players will move up one batting order position with every game with the lead off batter batting last in the next game. This progression continues even when a player may be absent for a game.***
- 5. Every player shall play at least one defensive inning(3 outs) at an infield position. The Pitcher and Catcher positions shall be considered infield positions.***
- 6. Adult coaches are not allowed on the field during the course of the games***

### ***Girls Major League Age Defined***

A Girls Major League player's age is defined by that player's age on **December 31, 2009**

### ***Girls Major League Tryout Information***

***All players MUST attend both scheduled tryouts. Failure to do so may jeopardize placement on a team.***
