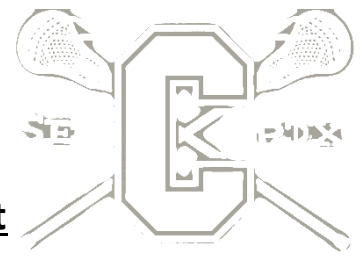


Cleveland Boys Lacrosse Club



Family Volunteer and Fundraising Commitment

The successful operation of Cleveland Boys Lacrosse is dependent on the financial and volunteer commitment of our families. The program could not survive without this commitment. Cleveland Boys Lacrosse Club is a non-profit team whose financial responsibilities are met, in part, through team fees paid by participating families. These team fees do not fully cover the cost of club operation. Therefore, additional revenue in the form of fundraising and sponsorship is required to sustain the club from year to year. Program events throughout the season are run, in part, through family volunteers and provide an essential experience for the players. As a result, family volunteer participation and fundraising efforts are required as explained below.

Please note: Families cannot substitute extra volunteer hours for fundraising commitment amounts and vice versa.

Fundraising Commitment

Families are required to meet a minimum fundraising and/or sponsorship commitment amount.

Team	Commitment
Varsity	\$125
JV	\$125

The program organizes events throughout the year (including the “off-season”) to make reaching the commitment level possible. Some of these events include Sales, Youth Clinics, and additional opportunities to be announced.

Fundraising commitments are satisfied[€] by the amount Cleveland Boys Lacrosse Club receives over expenses (not necessarily the gross amount per event). Acquiring corporate sponsorship funds *may* count dollar for dollar toward the fundraising commitment.

€Families that do not fulfill their commitment by the end of the regular season will be billed for the amount not satisfied. Players in families with outstanding bills will not receive end of year letters and/or certificates. In addition, families with outstanding bills will not be able to participate in subsequent seasons.

Family Volunteer Commitment

We ask that families assist the program by contributing volunteer time toward setting up and running games and helping with other program events. The minimum number of games required of families is listed below.[‡]

Team	Comittment*
Varisty	2 games
JV	2 games

*Volunteer game commitment for families with more than one player is based on the “varsity” game committment above.

‡If a family has not met the “2 game” commitment by the last regular season game a \$10.00 per unfulfilled game fee (up to a maximum of \$20.00) will be added onto the family’s account. Players in families with outstanding bills will not receive end of year letters and/or certificates. In addition, families with outstanding bills will not be able to participate in subsequent seasons.

Extenuating Circumstances

However, we do not want these contributions (time and money) to prevent any student from being able to play lacrosse.
