

# Braintree Summer Classic Softball Tournament Rules for 10U

#	Rule(s) Description:
1	Each team will be required to have in their possession a team roster, complete with birth certificate for each player. Please check in at the snack bar before your first game to insure we have your correct contact information.
2	Game captains, coaches and umpire meeting. Line-ups, ground rules discussed. Double coin toss to determine home team in Round Robin play.
3	Standard ASA rules apply with the following exceptions.
4	Mercy rule: 12 after 4 innings. <b>There is a limit of 4 runs per inning until the 7<sup>th</sup> inning then unlimited runs allowed also the umpire can declare last inning and unlimited runs allowed.</b> No inning can start after 1 one hour and 30 minutes. <i>Coaches please keep the game moving by quickly getting the girls on and off the field between innings.</i>
5	Pitch from 35 feet with 11 inch ball. 10 fielders (4 outfielders) Continuous batting order with free substitutions. No drop third – No infield fly rule Can only steal one base at a time and no stealing home. Any pitching who hits 3 batters in an inning or 4 in a game must be remove from mound But can stay in the game at another position.
6	Round robin games can end in a tie. The home team of all round robin games will be determined by a double coin flip.
7	Sunday's Single elimination games will use the international tie-breaker after 7 innings or 1 hour 30 minutes (whichever occurs first- except for the Semi-Finals and Championship games which will have no time limit.) Mercy rule in effect on Sunday is 15 runs after 3 innings; 12 after 4 innings, 8 after 5 innings.
8	Highest seed is home team in single elimination for Sunday's play. At the conclusion of pool play the seeds will be determined at end of Saturday by (1) head-to-head, (2) runs allowed, (3) runs scored or (4) coin toss.
9	Tournament director can change schedules, shorten games, and revise format in the event of inclement weather.
10	Umpire in charge will settle all disputes at the field.
11	No Slashing allowed
