Registration Instructions

Deadline Completed form and registration requirements are due by July 15, 2010. Scanned documents, images, photos or any other electronically generated documentation is acceptable. We understand that deadlines seem harsh to those that forget or are unable to register at that time for various reasons. The result of not having these deadlines is a poorly run and frustrating season for all. The club makes every attempt through its website (www.shepaugsoccerclub.com), local newspapers, flyers in the Region 12 School System, local access TV(channel 17), and signs around the 3 towns (Bridgewater, Roxbury & Washington) to inform the public of when registration has started. Not "knowing" is not an excuse.

Late Fee A late fee will be assessed for any late registrations received after July 15. Acceptance of late registration (between 7/15 and 8/1/2010) is subject to the approval of the SSC board members. Implementation of the late fee is to ensure that the SSC can meet the obligations and deadlines established by the Northwest Connecticut Junior Soccer Association (CJSA – <http://www.nwsoccer.net/>).
