- F-Resident Freshman

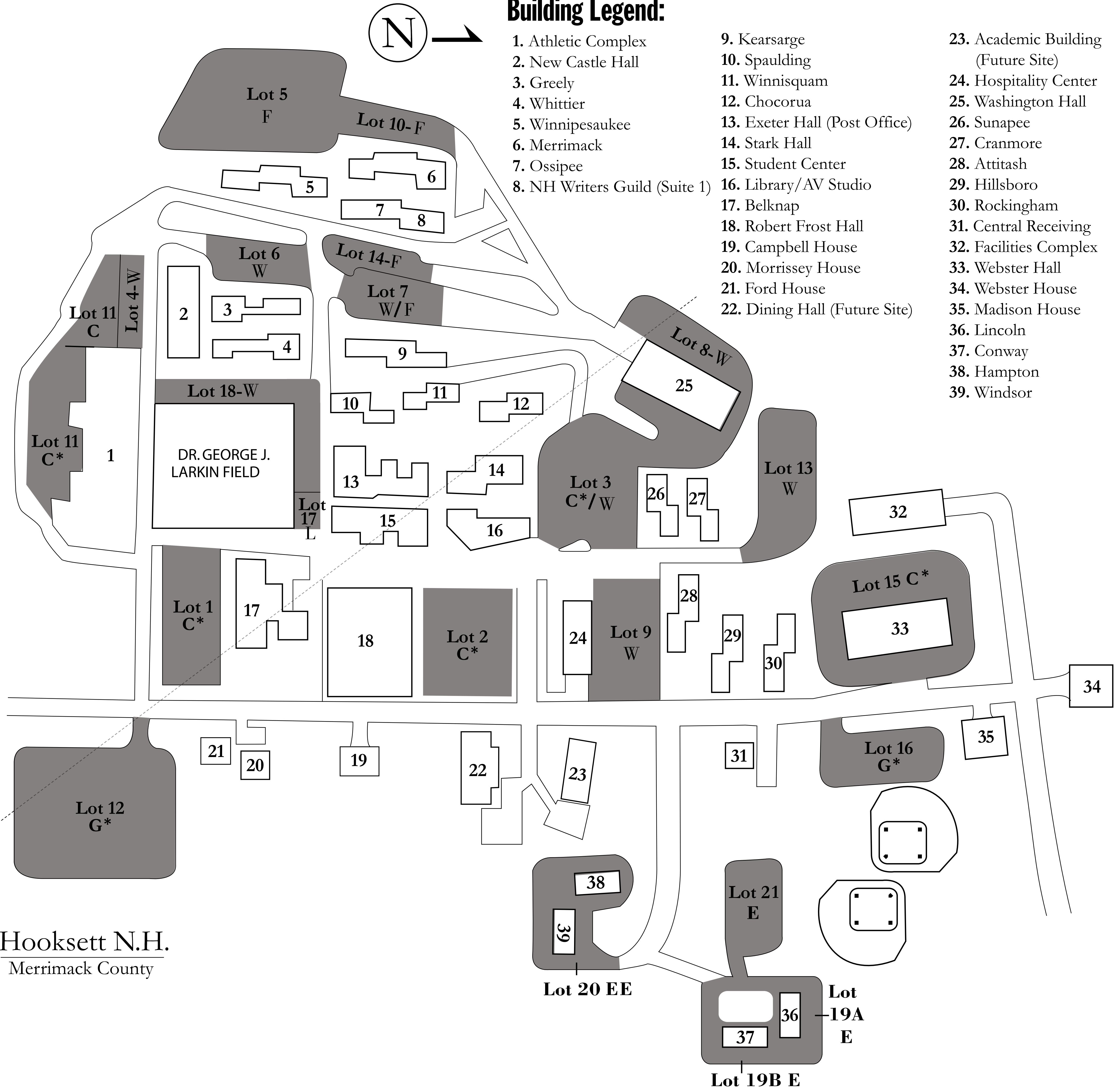
**\*No Parking Midnight to 6a.m.**

**EE Decals** will be issued to non-freshman residents of Hampton and Windsor. This decal authorizes you to park in lot 20, the parking lot of Hampton and Windsor, on a first come first serve basis. If there are no spaces available in lot 20 then you may temporarily park on the West side of campus in any resident lot designated as a "W" lot until the completion and opening of the new parking lot on the East side (lot 21).

Once construction of the new parking lot off of East side drive (lot 21) is completed you will be allowed to park in it or in any East side parking lot. Once lot 21 is open for parking EE decals will no longer be permitted to park on the West side of campus in any "W" lot. All East side residents (Hampton, Windsor, Conway and Lincoln) will only be allowed to park on the East side of campus in lots 19, 20 and 21. Lot 21 is anticipated to be open in the late fall of this year.
