Referee Pay:

Referees are an essential part of the successful operation of the travel and recreational soccer programs at Warrenton Youth Sports Club. Accordingly, we make every effort to reward our most dedicated and experienced referees.

Starting in the Spring of 2015 season, pay for our referees will be based on

- Experience
- Performance before, during and after the games
- Communication
- Proper uniform (**all 2nd year referees are required to have two different color jerseys- one must be black**)
- Attendance at meetings/trainings
- Acceptance of assigned games via email from website

There will be no bonus system this season for amount of games worked.

Referees will be notified of their pay rate prior to the beginning of the season

Referee Responsibilities:

Prior to the start of the season,

- Read and understand WYSC's game rules, posted at WYSC's web page. <http://www.wysc.org/>
- Read and understand each division's specific rules under the Divisions and Teams tab.
- If you have any questions contact referee assigner at cgleason@wysc.org
- Complete, sign and send, the last page of this form.
- Work the WYSC Referee Mandatory meeting (date and time TBD)
- Work any training scrimmages
- Fill out the Referee Availability form located on the referee page and email it to referee@wysc.org by August 23, 2015. (ODSL schedule will be posted by August 29th. WAGS schedule will be posted by August 30th.)
- Accept all games through the website by the email you get when assigned a game.

Prior to each game you are assigned to referee:

- Arrive at playing field no less than 20 minutes before the start of the game.
- Complete a field safety / readiness inspection especially the nets!
- Pre-game instructions to players.
- Player equipment inspection.

Post Game

- Complete game report.
 - ✓ Have both coaches sign the report. **DO NOT TURN IN REPORT.**
 - ✓ **This report will be your proof of having worked a game.**
 - ✓ Copy of game report can be downloaded from WYSC's soccer referee's webpage
 - ✓ **YOU MUST KEEP** a game report for each game you work.

- Referees are not required to report scores. **Keep game report as your proof you worked the game.**
- Fill out a report on any red/yellow cards or warnings given during any game
- Fill out an incident report on any injuries during game

Please read and make sure you understand the following basic rules:

This is a job, players, parents and the club count on you.

- **If you find yourself unable to attend your scheduled game, you need to;**
 - **If less than 6 days before the game, you will be responsible for finding your own replacement referee for the game/s. Once you have found a replacement referee, contact WYSC to get approval for the replacement ref.**
 - **If more than 7 days before the game, contact WYSC by phone and email. WYSC will try to help you find a replacement.**
 - **You can email referee@wysc.org to ask for assistance in sending out an email to other referees to help find a replacement referee.**
- Arrive no less than 20 minutes before the start of a game.
- Referees will be paid **ONCE** a season, after the end of season.
- Only the referee assignor can re-schedule game assignments.
- All recreational games are held Saturday or Sunday, at Athey fields, across the street from Fauquier H.S.
- The first game on Saturday starts at 9:00 A.M.
- The first game on Sunday may start at 12:00 PM. Most Sunday games will not start before 12:30 P.M.
- Whenever possible referees will be assigned a minimum of 2 games per day.
- The end of season tournament will result in more games being assigned to referees due to the high volume of games being played that weekend.

Travel games will be assigned to referees based on:

- Seniority within WYSC.
- Experience / Prior performance.
- WYSC recreational or travel players.

WYSC will hold its end of season Recreational Tournament on October 24th & 24th. Each team in the league will play at least 3 games that weekend. The rain date for the tournament is October 31st & November 1st.

- **Referees missing any of their scheduled games, may be removed from his/her remaining scheduled games.**
- **If you find yourself unable to attend your scheduled game, you need to;**
 - **If less than 7 days** before the game, you will be responsible for finding your own replacement referee for the game/s. Once you have found a replacement referee, contact WYSC to get approval of the replacement ref.
 - **If 7 or more days** before the game, contact WYSC by phone and email. WYSC will try to help you find a replacement. **But the ultimate responsibility of finding a replacement is yours.**

WYSC's primary concern is the safety of the players and referees.

As the game referee, you represent WYSC, your primary responsibility is the safety of all players, for each and every game. Dangerous play should never be allowed. It is your, responsibility to control the game, and address any dangerous play.

Coaches or parent should never be allowed on the field without your previous permission.
