



Board Meeting Minutes

**Opening**

The regular meeting of the South Central Soccer Academy (SCSA) was called to order at 5:30 p.m. EST on May 10, 2018, at SCSA.

**Open Issues:**

A. Dave - Cell Tower update on approval from Bargersville & Vectren use for corner lot We have to sign something for a variance. Looks like zoning has been approved and then notifications being sent out to everyone. We have already received the first payment. We have to invoice them \$833/month

B. Ryan – Bid Harding Group - \$186,400 (interested in doing sponsorship – Ryan to go back to him for details on the sponsorship) No further details. Business isn't doing very well right now.

1. Bid Wallace Construction - \$177,668 Voted (Dave/Michelle Brunsman)

Dave/Jeff to get line of credit back up. Been approved for 100K, may ask for more.

2. Bid - Otto (Steve Sawa) \$4600 for bumpers every 5-6' around perimeter of lot (interested in doing sponsorship) \$2219 for striping. Voted (Dave/Ryan)

C. Steve – IN Soccer Child Abuse Certification Law (Federal) – Update since April board meeting only volunteer coaches, travel coaches, team managers and other club staff are required to be certified. Needs to be completed before start of the season.

**New Business**

a) Nick - Rec Update – slow start with weather; season going well; rec festival next weekend. Registration is out for the fall. Numbers are a little lower, but not crazy drops; satellites are doing well (Whiteland/Perry/Greenwood not so much-a lot of

competition over in that area) ie. Whiteland has 3 u10 boys teams – Has been great advertising

b) Nick – Travel Update, Cup Results & 7/8U Jr Academy Info – Travel going well. Teams did well in Challenge Cup. Six teams advanced.

c) Nick - Junior Academy Update –

- We plan to have an event on FB live and share what it is about this coming Monday, May 14<sup>th</sup>
- Two practices/week during fall/spring – led by academy staff
- Inhouse League – Play games on the weekend (parent coached)
- Exceptional players we will invite to play up with U9s
- Affordable
- 1 Outside game with another club
- Not a full year commitment (breaks down into 3 periods)
- Different than req, but not full commitment to academy
- You join and will be with that same group all season
- Gender specific
- Games will be 4x4
- Profile: High interest in soccer; athletic/competitive; excels amongst peer group
- Day of week for games TBD
- Considered as Rec not Travel
- Price - \$200-\$250/fall & spring - \$100-\$150/winter
- Adidas shorts/black socks/2 shirts
- Playing in tournament is TBD – Mark/Nick feel it should be free for them to play – Suggested to cut price to register in half – Maybe consider a different event (future stars vs. academy jrs possibly add this to the Rec Festival)

d) Steve – Tourney Update – Slow registration, but starting to pick up-107 teams

e) Michelle – Party on the Pitch Update - doing a good job on donations; a lot still in the works (free stuff; reduced stuff) Michael is working on the food. Approximately 3-4K in donations.
