



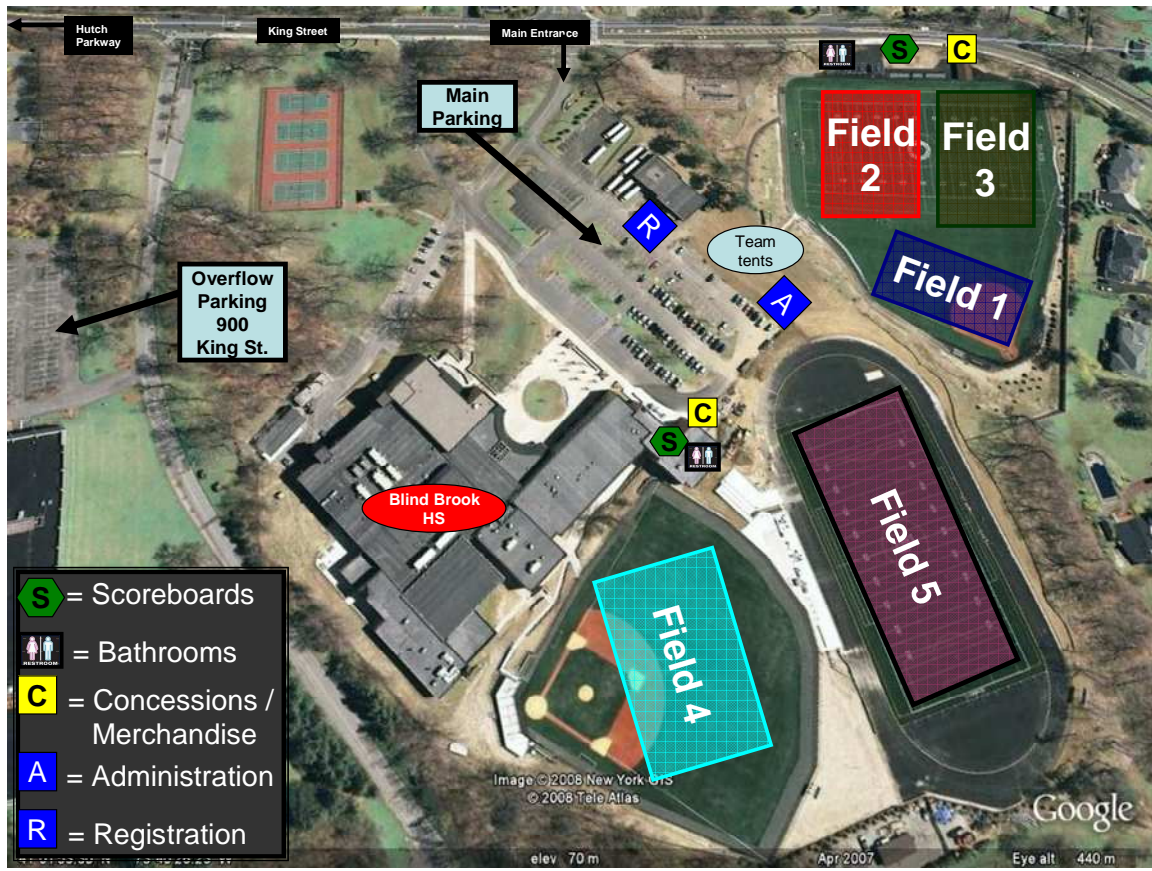
Last Licks RBYS Kickoff Classic 09'

Coaches,

1. Parking – **CARPOOLING IS HIGHLY ENCOURAGED** – as parking will be limited
 - All cars are to initially follow the directions to the BBHS lot <http://www.ryebrooksoccer.org/subpage3.html>
 - The main lot at the field complex will be open on both days but only has 150 spaces and will fill up fast
 - Overflow parking will be accommodated in the adjacent 900 King Street parking facility - The alternate lot is a very short walk to the fields
 - Handicap Parking and Handicap drop off ONLY – can follow directions to the King Street Handicap Lot
 - Parking Lot Staff will be available to direct you as you enter the lot
2. Check In:
 - **ALL** teams must check in a MINIMUM of ½ hr prior to their scheduled game time at the Registration Tent (located on lower end of the parking lot – see attached map)
 - The coach must show all their player and coach passes at the check in desk as well as their medical forms. Non WYSL/AYSO teams can do not need passes
 - Coaches will receive their tournament packet with their schedule and their team photo time at the check in tent
 - **MEETING PLACE** – there are 2 good central meeting places for your team. The first is on the grassy area next to the Registration Tent. The second is next to the brick vestibule which is the entrance for Field 4 and 5 (u12 and u14 teams)
3. Games:
 - **Location** – All games will be played at the Blind Brook HS/Rye Brook Athletic Field Complex on King Street in Rye Brook
 - **Fields** – 5 fields will be running at the same time, with all u9-u11 games at the main lower complex, and all u12-u14 at the upper complex
 - **Players on the field** - U9 and u10 play 8v8 / u11 plays 9v9 and u12&u14 play 11v11
 - **Game Time** - All games are 25 minutes – and all teams play 4 games
 - **Game changeovers** - The coach is responsible for having their team on the field and ready to play when the games begin (there is only a 2 minute change over between games)
 - **Jerseys** - Coaches MUST have their teams bring their home and away jerseys (if they have them) – if you do not have 2 uniforms, you will be required to bring pinnies. Away team must wear alternate jersey or pinny if the uniforms of the opponent are similar
 - **Game Start Up** – game will begin on time regardless of if a team in on the field or not,. Games start and end on the airhorn sound
 - **Speed Subbing** - Speed subbing will be in effect – as soon as the ref acknowledges the sub, coaches are encouraged to send their players on the field while the players on the field are coming off. You also may ONLY sub on your throw in and all goal kicks.
 - **Game Balls** - Games balls will be provided
4. Field Activities:
 - **Field Surface Access** - Players and Coaches ONLY are allowed inside the fences and on the playing surface. Spectators/parents MUST stay on the field perimeter – we ask the coaches to help us enforce this
 - **Pre and post game** locations - Teams are required to site their teams in the designated areas or on the field perimeters when they are not playing. Under no circumstances will the teams be allowed to site themselves between fields 2&3
 - **Skills Contests** and demonstrations will be held throughout the day on the lower field – with prizes for winners
 - **Team Pictures** - Every team will get a tournament team picture – please make sure to have your entire team at the designated photo area at your designated time – photo schedules will be given out at registration
 - **Trophies** - All players on the winning teams get a 1st place trophy and all players on the 2nd place teams get a 2nd place trophy . All u9/u10 players on 3rd-5th place teams get a participation trophy
 - **Awards Ceremony** – This is one of the highlights of our event and is conducted in the stadium (Field 5) immediately following the conclusion of the last games (12:35pm and 6:05pm). Parents will be required to stay in the bleachers and all teams will stay on the track until they are announced
5. Weather - The event is rain or shine
 - **Severe Weather** - In the event of severe weather or the field being covered by snow – we will post a cancellation notice on the club web site www.ryebrooksoccer.org by 6:30am game day.
 - **Shelter** - There is little to no shelter on the field and the HS will not be open. Please bring appropriate clothing for between games and umbrellas or shelters in case of rain.
 - **Tents** - are allowed to be sited on the grassy area overlooking the lower fields. They will not be allowed on the turf fields
6. General:
 - **Concessions** - The main concession stand (on the lower field) will be open from 8am-5:30pm. The upper stand from 9am-5pm.
 - **Bathrooms** - The Lower field will have a port-a-san complex behind the bleachers, and the upper field has a bathroom complex under the brick entry vestibule
 - **Pets** - There are no pets allowed on the field
 - **Garbage** - Teams will be expected to police their own garbage
 - **Chairs** - Parents of players u9-u12 are encouraged to bring chairs to sit . The lower bleachers do not provide good game viewing and the u12 field has NO seating. All u14 and u15 games are played in the stadium which has over 1200 bleacher seats. Chairs will not be allowed on the field level at the Stadium
 - Parents may not communicate with the referees either before, during or after the games
 - Any questions are to be directed to the field manager or any of the tournament staff volunteer staff (wearing the blue tournament shirts) – or the tournament officials (wearing the Red shirts)

DIRECTIONS:

The main tournament lot at the High School will be open both days, with additional parking available at the alternate tournament lot at 900 King Street (lot #2)

DIRECTIONS FROM THE SOUTH TO THE MAIN TOURNAMENT LOT: Hutchinson River Parkway North to exit 30S - King Street. Make a right onto King Street. Go to through 2 lights (past the Village Hall and tennis courts on the right). Make a right into Blind Brook HS. Follow the driveway into the main parking lot.

FROM THE NORTH - 684 Corridor TO THE MAIN TOURNAMENT LOT: 684 South to Exit 2 - Airport. Make a left and go into the airport. At the rotary, go 270 degrees and make a right onto Rye Lake Road. Go to the end and make a right onto King Street. Take King Street for several miles, and cross over the Hutchinson River Parkway. Go to through 2 lights (past the Village Hall and tennis courts on the right). Make a right into Blind Brook HS. Follow the driveway into the main parking lot.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE NORTH (CT) MERRIT PKWY TO THE MAIN TOURNAMENT LOT: Merrit to exit 27s (the second King Street exit past the rest stop and just under the overpass). Make a right onto N.Ridge Street. At the intersection, make a right onto King Street. Go over the bridge, through 2 lights (past the Village Hall and tennis courts on the right). Make a right into Blind Brook HS. Follow the driveway into the main parking lot.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE NORTH (CT) 95 TO THE MAIN TOURNAMENT LOT: 95 south to route 287 west. 287 west to exit 9 N-S Hutchinson River Parkway. Get to your right. Go through the light and bear right on the Hutchinson River parkway north. Hutchinson River Parkway North to exit 30S - King Street. Make a right onto King Street. Go to through 2 lights (past the Village Hall and tennis courts on the right). Make a right into Blind Brook HS. Follow the driveway into the main parking lot.

DIRECTIONS TO THE HANDICAP LOT: To get to the Handicap lot, follow the directions for the HS lot. Instead of making the right into the HS, stay straight on King Street. Pass through 1 more light, and then make your first right into the Handicap lot immediately adjacent to the field complex. **THE HANDICAP LOT IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR DROP OFF OR PICK UP**
