Parents and Players,

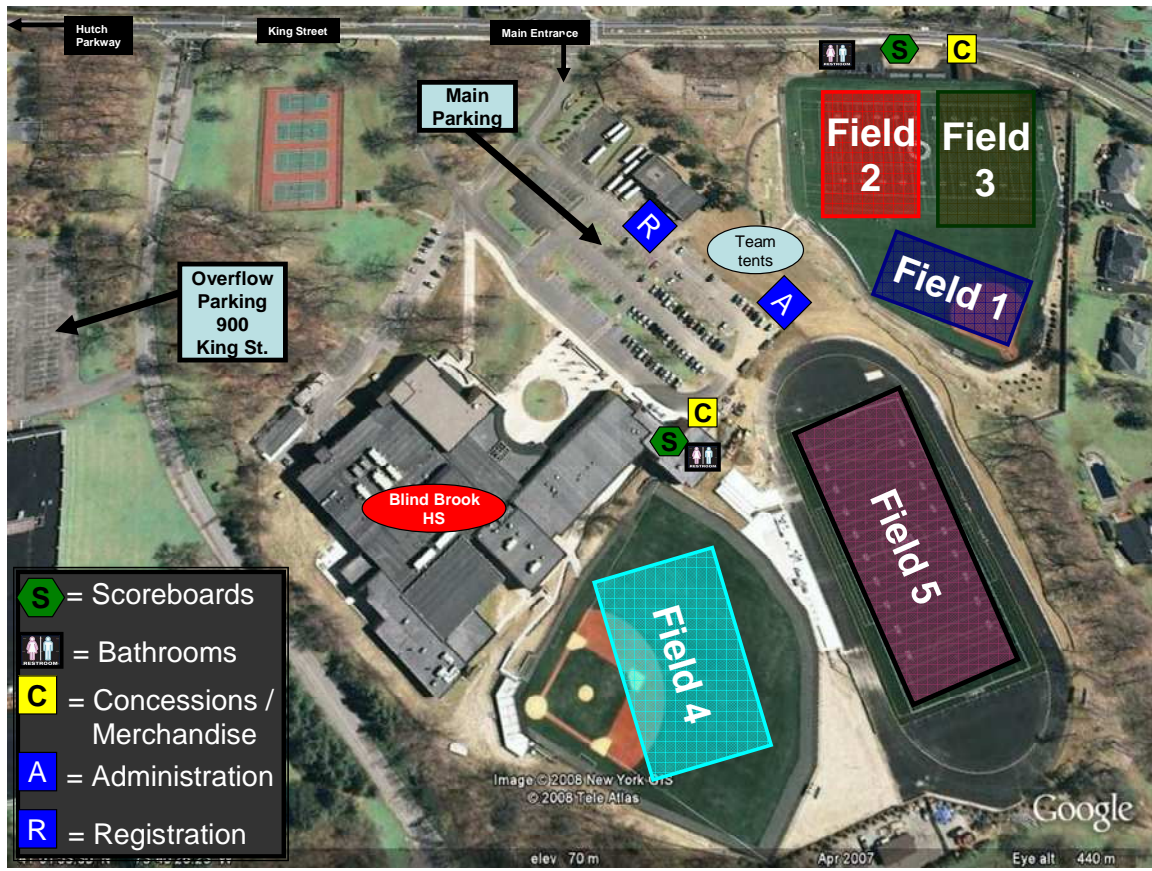
Here is a fact sheet we hope you will find helpful as you prepare to attend our event.

1. Parking – **CARPPOOLING IS HIGHLY ENCOURAGED** – as parking will be limited
 - All cars are to initially follow the directions to the BBHS lot (see directions below)
 - The main lot at the field complex will be open on both days but only has 150 spaces and will fill up fast
 - Overflow parking will be accommodated in the adjacent 900 King Street parking facility - The alternate lot is a very short walk to the fields
 - Handicap Parking and Handicap drop off **ONLY** (THERE IS NO PARKING, DROP OFF OR STANDING IN THIS LOT - NO EXCEPTIONS) can follow directions to the King Street Handicap Lot
 - Parking Lot Staff will be available to direct you as you enter the lot
2. Check In:
 - It is up to your coach where and when you meet – check with your coach for details
3. Timing:
 - Morning sessions start at either 8am, 8:28am or 8:54am. The morning session ends at 12:30pm with the awards ceremony. The afternoon starts at 1:30pm, 1:57pm or 2:24pm and ends at 6pm with the awards ceremony.
 - The awards ceremony is conducted immediately after the end of each session in the Stadium
 - Your coach will provide you with your individual game times
4. Players:
 - **Footwear** – our fields are all synthetic Field Turf, and players can use just about any authorized soccer footwear including cleats
 - **Uniforms** – your coach will tell you what uniforms to bring, but teams with home and alternate jerseys will be required to have both
 - **Clothing** – we highly recommend you dress your child in layers. The field complex offers no real shelter, and if it is cold or rainy, the players should have clothing to change into after the games – ALL CLOTHING SHOULD HAVE YOUR NAME AND CONTACT INFO INSIDE THEM – lost and found will be located at the registration desk
 - **Balls** – we HIGHLY recommend all balls have your players name clearly written on them, as a ton of balls will be on the fields
 - **Trophies** - All players on the winning teams get a 1st place trophy and all players on the 2nd place teams get a 2nd place trophy . All u9/u10 players on 3rd-5th place teams get a participation trophy.
5. Parents:
 - **Field Restrictions**- Parents are NOT allowed on the playing surfaces or inside the fences unless they are authorized coaches
 - **Parent Seating** - Parents of players u9-u12 are encouraged to bring chairs to sit . The lower bleachers do not provide good game viewing. All u14 and u15 games are played in the stadium which has over 1200 bleacher seats. Chairs will not be allowed on the field level. Field 4 (u12) has no seating, so you must bring your own chairs
 - Parents may not communicate with the referees either before, during or after the games
6. Weather - The event is rain or shine
 - In the event of severe weather or the field being covered by snow – we will post a cancellation notice on the club web site by 6:30am game day at www.ryebrooksoccer.org
 - There is little to no shelter on the field and the HS will not be open. Please bring appropriate clothing for between games and umbrellas or shelters in case of rain.
7. General:
 - **CONCESSIONS** - The main concession stand located next to the registration are on the lower field will be open from 8am-5:30pm, and the concession stand at the upper field, located at the entrance to the upper complex, will be open from 9am-5pm.
 - **BATHROOMS** - The Lower field will have a port-a-san complex behind the bleachers, and the upper field has a bathroom complex under the brick entry vestibule
 - **PETS** - There are no pets allowed on the field
 - **GARBAGE** - Parents will be expected to police their own garbage
 - **TEAM PICTURES** - Every team will get a tournament team picture that will be posted on line – please make sure to ask your coach for him to send you a copy or the link to download the picture yourself.
 - **TENTS** - are allowed to be sited on the grassy area overlooking the lower fields. They will not be allowed on the turf fields
 - Any questions are to be directed to the field manager or any of the tournament staff volunteer staff (wearing the blue tournament shirts – or the tournament officials wearing the Red shirts)

DIRECTIONS:

The main tournament lot at the High School will be open both days, with additional parking available at the alternate tournament lot at 900 King Street (lot #2)

DIRECTIONS FROM THE SOUTH TO THE MAIN TOURNAMENT LOT: Hutchinson River Parkway North to exit 30S - King Street. Make a right onto King Street. Go to through 2 lights (past the Village Hall and tennis courts on the right). Make a right into Blind Brook HS. Follow the driveway into the main parking lot.

FROM THE NORTH - 684 Corridor TO THE MAIN TOURNAMENT LOT: 684 South to Exit 2 - Airport. Make a left and go into the airport. At the rotary, go 270 degrees and make a right onto Rye Lake Road. Go to the end and make a right onto King Street. Take King Street for several miles, and cross over the Hutchinson River Parkway. Go to through 2 lights (past the Village Hall and tennis courts on the right). Make a right into Blind Brook HS. Follow the driveway into the main parking lot.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE NORTH (CT) MERRIT PKWY TO THE MAIN TOURNAMENT LOT: Merrit to exit 27s (the second King Street exit past the rest stop and just under the overpass). Make a right onto N.Ridge Street. At the intersection, make a right onto King Street. Go over the bridge, through 2 lights (past the Village Hall and tennis courts on the right). Make a right into Blind Brook HS. Follow the driveway into the main parking lot.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE NORTH (CT) 95 TO THE MAIN TOURNAMENT LOT: 95 south to route 287 west. 287 west to exit 9 N-S Hutchinson River Parkway. Get to your right. Go through the light and bear right on the Hutchinson River parkway north. Hutchinson River Parkway North to exit 30S - King Street. Make a right onto King Street. Go to through 2 lights (past the Village Hall and tennis courts on the right). Make a right into Blind Brook HS. Follow the driveway into the main parking lot.

DIRECTIONS TO THE HANDICAP LOT: To get to the Handicap lot, follow the directions for the HS lot. Instead of making the right into the HS, stay straight on King Street. Pass through 1 more light, and then make your first right into the Handicap lot immediately adjacent to the field complex. **THE HANDICAP LOT IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR DROP OFF OR PICK UP**
