Dear PCYOI Member,

Welcome back to another hockey season! In this packet you will find the registration materials for the 2010-11 season. Registration packets include the following forms:

- Registration Form
- Participation Obligation Agreement
- USA Hockey Consent to Treat
- Coaching Application (fill out only if interested candidate)

Please make sure to fill out the forms completely and return with a check for your fees by AUGUST 15, 2010. *REMEMBER to go to www.usahockey.com to register your skater(s) with USA Hockey/WAHA. (You must include a USA confirmation sheet for each skater with your registration materials.) Full fees are due upon registration for INTRODUCTION TO HOCKEY AND THE IN-HOUSE PROGRAM. Fees for TRAVELING PLAYERS can be paid in two installments. To do this, please include two checks, one dated for the date you register and one post-dated November 30, 2010 (both checks must be received with registration to qualify for early bird pricing). We will hold the second check until November 30. You may select the option to pay by credit card. There will be a \$15 service charge for this option and your card will be charged one time for your entire fees on or after November 30, 2010. Please note that if you are planning on trying out for SPASH Hockey, but plan to skate in PCYOI evaluations you must register with us as well as USA Hockey and provide these materials as well as \$50 by the first day of evaluations for the ice time used during evaluation period and up to SPASH tryouts. If you do not make SPASH and skate with a PCYOI team, this \$50 will be applied to your total fees. If you make SPASH the \$50 is nonrefundable.

Remember the service hour requirements are as follows:

Introduction to Hockey: No hours

In-House: 10 hours, all of which must be completed in the concession stand or at Riverfront (NEW only 6 of Riverfront hours can go toward concession requirements)

Travel teams: 25 hrs (40 hr maximum per family) and 14 of those hours MUST be completed in either the concession stand or at Riverfront Rendezvous (NEW only 6 of Riverfront hours can go toward family concession stand requirements, additional hours are applied as general hours.)

Girls U12/U14: To Be Determined after girls co-op associations meet.

We want to remind people that this is a volunteer run organization and it is essential that ALL of us continue to put in the time and energy needed to keep our rink clean and running smoothly! This will help us continue to keep operating costs down and continue to attract other user groups to our beautiful facility. It is because of these other groups that we are able to keep hockey affordable for our membership.

We WILL NOT mail any information on evaluations or fundraising. Evaluation information will be available on the website and at the rink by the beginning of September. Fundraising materials will be available at evaluations. We will also continue to do our best to update members via emails, but please continue to check the website (www.pcyoi.net) for updates and information. Also, remember that there are volunteer opportunities available in the concession stand now through the fall. What a great way to get a start on this season's hours! Please stop in the rink and check the concession book.

Please tell any people new to PCYOI that our onsite registration days will be Wednesday, September 8th; Monday, September 13th; and Wednesday, September 15th from 5 to 8 p.m. at Ice Hawks Arena. Equipment handout will be at the same time. Thanks!
