****I**** Meeting called to order @ 6:30pm

****II**** Motion to skip the reading of the April 16, 2010 minutes and vote them into record. Yes-8, No-0

****III**** New Business

A Due to the number of complete days rained out so far, Todd would like to reschedule one of those days to the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend. Yes-8, No-0

(1) Todd will send an email out by Wednesday to coaches notifying them of the added games.

(2) If a team will not have enough players present for the game, the coach needs to contact Todd so he can cancel the game.

B All-Stars

(1) Not charging a fee to be in All-Stars this year (\$50 in past years)

(2) Teams will be provided t-shirts instead of jerseys this year. Hats/visors will also be provided.

(3) \$182 per team for hat/visor and shirt.

(4) SCBA will cover the cost of our 4th of July Tournament and up to \$300 towards the entry fee of one other tournament per All-Star team.

(5) Each coach can recommend 2-5 players from his team to be on All-Stars. These players need to be ranked using the player stats as a tool.

(6) There will be 12 players per team and 2 alternates. 12 uniforms will be bought.

(8)A third team can be created if a coach wants to take on that task, but they will wear their uniforms from the regular season (an All-Star uniform will not be provided) and will get into our tournament for free, but will have to pay for any other tournaments they want to play in.

*C*4th of July Tournament

(1)Renee will be sending out the tournament rules from last year to go over at the next meeting. Everyone needs to look them over and provide any input.

*D*SDSL

(1)Steve Moore was present and expressed concern about the player level and how the draft worked.

(2)He also questioned the possibility of a player who has made great progress during the season on the rec SDSL teams being allowed to play on the All-Star team for tournaments. If not, can they put together their own All-Star team.

Note: The SDSL creates All-Star teams and Rec teams before the regular season starts that play together for the whole season. These teams are suppose to play other All-Star teams or Rec teams during their season. The All-Star teams go on to play in the tournaments after the regular season is over. Teams that play in the SCBA only, have coaches submit players names who they believe are the most qualified from their team (from the players who stated they would be willing and available to play on an All-Star team during their registration) to be on an All-Star team. That list is gone over by the All-Star coaches for that division and the division coordinator to create a team of what they believe are the most qualified for their All-Star team. That is being done at the end of May this year.

(3)Todd suggests having a meeting with the SDSL parents at the end of the year to see what the parents liked and what they didn't and to see what improvements need to be made.
