CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT**

As a parent/guardian or COBRA player in the Howard County Lacrosse Program, I will abide by the code of conduct outlined in this agreement.

**As a parent/guardian**, I will always offer words of encouragement and cheer for my child's team in a positive manner. I will refrain from making negative comments to any player, coach, parent or official. I will never yell at or berate the referees. I will refrain from the use of alcohol, tobacco and drugs while attending practices, games or other HCLP-sponsored events.

**As a player**, I will always do my best. I will respect my teammates, my coaches and the referees. I will not use foul language or show poor sportsmanship. I deserve to play in an alcohol-, tobacco- and drug-free environment and I expect adults to respect that wish.

**As a COBRA parent/player**, I understand that COBRA must be my primary spring sport; this encompasses spring preseason practices and tournaments, games, and regular season and postseason tournaments. This commitment officially starts March 1 and includes postseason tournaments, which will end no later than the second weekend in June. I understand that unexcused absences will result in disciplinary action, including suspension from games, and if unexcused absences continue, removal from COBRA for the remainder of the season.

Parents and Players will remember that sports are an opportunity to learn and have fun. HCLP requests that everyone allow the players to play, the coaches to coach, officials to officiate and the spectators to cheer.
