

Star Spangled Girls Lacrosse Tournament Weather Delays and Cancellations

Tournament Officials may suspend play on all fields based on weather or associated field conditions. The following actions will be taken as warranted.

Any delay of games will be for a minimum of 30 minutes. If play can be resumed at the end of 30 minutes, the games in progress will be completed. The next scheduled round of games will then begin on the nearest half-hour or hour and the full day's schedule will be completed if possible.

Tournament Officials may determine that the initial 30-minute delay must be extended due to weather or field conditions. At that time, all games in progress will be deemed complete and their scores recorded as final. When conditions permit, the next scheduled round of games will begin on the nearest half-hour or hour and the full day's schedule will be completed if possible.

Weather delays could potentially lead to cancellation of the remaining schedule for the day. If a full day's schedule cannot be completed, only those games played through the last full round of games in a Bracket will be used for point scoring purposes. The Tournament will then continue as scheduled on the next day. Games canceled because of weather or related field conditions will not be rescheduled.

In the event that Sunday's Championship Playoffs cannot be played because of weather or associated field conditions or because of earlier delays, Division Champions will be determined based on the point scoring system used for the Tournament.

We don't have any control over the weather. While this policy may not cover all conditions or answer all questions, it does establish the basic steps we will follow in the event of weather delays or cancellations.

This policy is final for the 2010 Tournament. Thank you for your understanding.
